# INSTALLING THE ADJUSTABLE FEET OR LEVELERS

- For base cabinet, attach the feet (HH) to the bottom using sixteen screws (AA) and tighten securely.

  Make sure side A of the adjustable feet (HH) is facing either towards the back or the front of the cabinet.
- For locker, attach four levelers (GG) directly to the bottom.



# **2** INSTALLING THE GROMMETS


Use the short side of the hex wrench to pry out the knock-outs of your desired cord access holes. Then install the grommets (KK) into those holes.

□ Insert shelf brackets (FF) into the slots at the desired heights and place the shelves over the shelf brackets (FF).








# ADJUSTING THE DOOR (IF APPLICABLE)

 Screw the inner screw on the soft closed hinge (R2) to adjust the gap between the doors and shell. Ensure the door is always level.



 Screw the outer screw on the soft closed hinge (R2) to adjust the gap between the doors. Ensure the door is always level.
 The gap should always be about 4 mm.


#### **DRAWER REMOVAL**

Empty the drawer. Pull the drawer out so it's almost fully extended. There are two black release levers, one on each side of the drawer. Pull up the black release lever on one side, while pushing down the black release lever on the other side. While holding the levers in the positions as instructed above, pull the drawer outward until it is released from the drawer slides (L1 & L2).


#### DRAWER REPLACEMENT

Extend the drawer slides (L1 & L2) from the tool chest or cabinet. Insert the brackets on each side of the drawer into the slots in the slides, being careful that they are properly positioned. Once properly inserted, completely close the drawer to set the slides in their proper positions.



# **7** CONNECTING TO THE WALL





**CAUTION**: The M6 x 40 hex tapping bolts (BB) should be drilled into the stud of the wall.


Bolt the safety bracket (II) with two screws (BB) to the stud in the wall. Fasten the locker by using the safety strap (JJ) to tie the locker and safety bracket (II) together.




Use the notch to line up the mounting brackets (I) and hang the wall cabinets.









Find the studs in the wall and bolt the bracket (I) to as many studs as possible using the bolts (BB).



Adjust the levelers (GG) and cover the holes.



Use the level on the mounting brackets (I) to ensure the mounting brackets (I) at the same level.



Hang the wall cabinet to the mounting bracket (I).

# **Maintenance**

- □ Check all the screws and nuts periodically for tightness. Tighten them when necessary.
- Check the safety strap periodically for tightness. Tighten it when necessary.

# **Care and Cleaning**

- Periodically clean the surfaces with a soft rag and water.
- □ Grease and oil can be removed with most standard cleaning fluids. For safety, use a nonflammable cleaning fluid.
