

This product is not intended for inclement / severe weather in any form including, but not limited to: rain, hail, sleet, snow and / or wind. The manufacturer recommends that with formidable weather approaching that you store and / or cover this set. Do not locate product near open flame. Do not use product as a support. Do not shake, lean or climb on product. Children under the age of 10, near the product, should be supervised by a competent adult at all times. This product is NOT intended for commercial use and will void the warranty.

To avoid damaging this product, assemble it on a soft, non-abrasive surface such as carpet or cardboard.







Chair Assembly

1 Attaching the support tube to the legs

- □ Place the left leg (H) on a soft place.
- Attach the support tube (E) to the left leg (H) using M8x28 combination hex bolts (DD).
- □ Repeat the above steps to attach the right leg (G) to the support tube (E).
- Do not tighten all the bolts at this step.



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the wrench (GG).




2 Attaching the connection bars to the legs

- Attach the two connection bars (F) to the right and the left leg (G & H) using M6x25 combination bolts (BB).
- Do not tighten all the bolts at this step.



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (FF).




3 Attaching the support tube to the chair seat

□ Attach the support tube (E) to the chair seat (D) using M8x28 combination hex bolts (DD).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the wrench (GG).




4 Attaching the chair seat to the right arm

- Attach the back of the chair seat (D) to the back of the right arm (A) and secure by an M6x15 combination bolt (AA).
- □ Attach the front of the chair seat (D) to the front of the right arm (A) using an M6x30 combination bolt (CC).
- Do not tighten all the bolts at this step.




NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (FF).




5 Attaching the chair seat to the left arm

- Repeat step 4 to attach the chair seat (D) to the left arm (B).
- Do not fully tighten all the bolts at this step.




6 Attaching the chair back to the arms

- Turn the chair right side up.
- □ Attach the chair back (C) to the right and the left arm (A & B) using M6x25 combination bolts (BB).
- □ Once all of the bolts are in place, fully tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (FF) and the wrench (GG).



7 Checking the chair


- □ Place the seat cushion (I) and the back cushion (J) to finish the assembly of the chair.
- Ensure all connections are secure before use.



Fire Pit Assembly

Attaching the table legs to the table top


- □ Place the table top (K) upside down on a soft surface.
- □ Attach the table legs (L) to the table top (K) using M6x25 combination bolts (BB) and plastic washers (EE).
- □ Do not fully tighten all the bolts at this step.



Fire Pit Assembly (continued)

2 Attaching the leg connector to the table legs


- □ Attach the leg connector (M) to the legs (L) using M6x25 combination bolts (BB).
- Once all of the bolts are in place, fully tighten the bolts using the hex wrench (FF).



Fire Pit Assembly (continued)

3 Tightening all bolts and adding the fire pit

- Once all bolts are in place, fully tighten all bolts.
- □ Turn the table right side up.
- Carefully place the fire bowl (S) in the table rim (K).
- Then place the following in order, from bottom to top: the log grate (Q), the barbecue grate (P) and the lid (0) or the cover (N).
- □ When not in use, store the poker (R) under the log grate (Q).



Care and Cleaning

- For best results, clean the frame and cushions with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- □ Store the fire pit and chairs in a dry sheltered place when not in use.
- □ Keep the fire pit and chairs away from extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow and wind.
