

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

### PLEASE FOLLOW THE PRECAUTIONS BELOW FOR YOUR NEW RETRO COOLER

1. The power switch should be put at the "OFF" position for over 5 minutes before changing the working mode (from cooling to warming or from warming to cooling).
2. When the cooling or warming function is on, keep in a well-ventilated area. Don't block the ventilation of the unit.
3. Do not operate under direct sunlight.
4. Do not disturb the airflow of the unit.
5. Do not pour water into the unit directly.
6. Do not use near water. Keep unit out of wet weather conditions.
7. Use damp cloth to clean the unit; do not submerge unit in water.
8. When leaving unit for a long time, put it in a well-ventilated area.
9. Avoid dropping unit.
10. Do not put carbonated beverage in unit when in warming function, this may cause unit to explode.
11. Keep unit away from fire or other flammable substances.
12. Do not store meats, poultry, fish, dairy products and other items that may spoil in unit for more than one hour.

### PROPER DISPOSAL

An empty RETRO COOLER is an extremely dangerous attraction to children. If you are getting rid of your old RETRO COOLER, please follow the instructions in the Child Entrapment Warning.

### CHILD ENTRAPMENT WARNING


Risk of child entrapment. Before you throw away your old RETRO COOLER:





## METHOD OF OPERATION

### 1. Electrical Outlet Use:



A. Ensure the function switch is in the off position and the unit is unplugged from any power source (electrical outlet or vehicle outlet).

B. Insert the narrow end of the AC adapter into the AC adapter jack on the product, and plug the other end into a standard 120-volt electrical outlet.



C. Slide the function switch to either the warm or cool position, as desired.

**NOTE:** It may take up to 45 minutes to cool or warm.

D. To turn the unit off, slide the function switch to the OFF position and then unplug it from the power source.

### 2. Vehicle Outlet Use:

**CAUTION:** Always connect the cord to the unit before connecting it to the power source. Use only the adapter provided with this unit.

The unit should only be operated while the engine is running to avoid draining the vehicle battery charge.

A. Connect the unit to 12-volt vehicle outlet.

B. Slide the function switch to either the WARM or COOL position, as desired.

**NOTE:** It may take up to 45 minutes to cool or warm.

C. To turn the unit off, slide the function switch to the OFF position and then unplug it from the power source.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

1.If unit stops functioning properly:

a.Disconnect unit

i.If plug is loose re-insert plug into DC power supply completely.

ii.If the cigarette lighter plug is loose (DC power supply),make sure lighter does not need to be cleaned.

iii.If the unit is still not properly functioning the cigarette lighter plug connect fuse could be blown, and should be changed by a proper automotive mechanic.

iv.If the car's power switch is off,the cigarette lighter may only function when car power is turned on.
