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Note: Almost all spills are removed by either dry cleaning fluid (follow manufacturer's instructions) or a simple solution of one teaspoon of mild detergent with one teaspoon of white vinegar in a quart of warm water.

\*If recommended procedure is not effective call a reputable cleaner. Some stains are so complex that they should be treated by someone with a knowledge of textile chemistry. Don't wait for annual cleaning. It may be too late to remove the stain.

Vacuum regularly. Pile shedding is a normal characteristic of quality area rugs. Avoid use of beater-bar type vacuum as they may cause yarns to pull or snag. If this happens, avoid pulling yarn knots out of surface pile. Clean spills immediately by blotting with a clean sponge or cloth. Professional clean only. Rug padding is recommended.

HAIR ON HIDE LEATHER COWHIDE SUEDE LEATHER Vacuum regularly on the lowest setting. Beater Bar vacuum is not recommended. Clean spills immediately by wiping smoothly in the direction of the hair with a damp (but not wet) cloth with mild soap and water. Professionally clean only. Natural skin rugs are not recommended for high traffic areas. Rug Pad is recommended.

JUTE SISAL Vacuum regularly. Due to the potential for rug damage, beater bar vacuums are not recommended. Remove spills immediately by blotting with a dry cloth. Professionally clean only. Do not steam clean or wet shampoo your jute rug. Plant fibers are highly absorbent, so when exposed to liquids or excessive dampness, they are subject to some shrinking and puckering. Rug padding is recommended.

VISCOSE LUXCELLE™ (FAUX SILK/COTTON) SILK-LIKE BAMBOO FIBERS Vacuum regularly. Beater Bar vacuum is not recommended. Avoid pulling yarn knots out of surface pile. Professionally clean only. Consumer self-cleaning methods are discouraged. The pile can easily stain and yellow with improper cleaning chemicals. If a spill should occur, it is recommended to blot the affected area with white paper towels or clean white terry cloth towel. Rubbing will distort the fiber and moisture will weaken the fiber, which can cause it to break or be damaged. With a soft brush, comb the face of the rug in the direction of the pile. Anticipate that the pile might look flatter and more reflective after grooming. Once dry, re-brush the fiber to regain original texture. Rug padding is recommended.

# CARE AND CLEANING | CONSTRUCTION

#### LOOP PILE

Proper and routine vacuuming of carpet is the best way to keep carpet clean. Nourison recommends using a suction only vacuum or a vacuum which allows for the brushes to be turned to the off position. Overly aggressive agitation of a vacuum can cause damage to all fine carpets and or natural fibers. When spot cleaning carpet always test colorfastness in an inconspicuous area. Always remove any solids before attempting to clean. For liquid spills gently blot the spot with a clean absorbent white cloth. Do not rub the spot or use a colored towel or cloth as this could result in damage to the area. For cleaning of large areas, rooms or deep cleaning seek a reputable professional carpet cleaning company with specific knowledge of cleaning the specific fiber of your carpet.

#### MACHINE MADE CUT PILE

Proper and routine vacuuming of carpet is the best way to keep carpet clean. A vacuum with brushes can be used. It is important to note that the vacuums brush height should always be set to the maximum height so that the brushes only come into contact with the tips of the surface pile. Overly aggressive agitation of a vacuum can cause damage to all fine carpets and or natural fibers. When spot cleaning carpet always test colorfastness in an inconspicuous area. Always remove any solids before attempting to clean. For liquid spills gently blot the spot with a clean absorbent white cloth. Do not rub the spot or use a colored towel or cloth as this could result in damage to the area. For cleaning of large areas, rooms or deep cleaning seek a reputable professional carpet cleaning company with specific knowledge of cleaning the specific fiber of your carpet.

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# HOW TO GET THE BEST OUT OF YOUR NOURISON BROADLOOM OR CUSTOM RUG

#### HOW TO LAY OUT YOUR RUG

PACKAGING AND SHIPPING MAY CREATE TEMPORARY CREASES OR CURLS. FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO FLATTEN YOUR RUG.



Place rolled-up rug on the floor and roll out flat. A non-slip rug pad is recommended for safety and floor protection.



Vacuum the rug without the beater bar to remove any shedding and dust. The pressure and vibration will help flatten out the rug.



Flatten out curled edges by rolling the rug in the opposite direction. Curled corners can be flattened by weighing them down with heavy books. Most rugs will relax and lie flat in a few days.

### BROADLOOM & CUSTOM RUG CARE AND CLEANING TIPS

EXTEND THE LIFE OF YOUR BROADLOOM OR CUSTOM RUG AND KEEP IT LOOKING ITS BEST.



#### **USE A RUG PAD**

We recommend a rug pad for all custom area rugs. A non-slip rug pad's primary benefits are safety and cushioning. However, it also prolongs the life of your rug and makes it easier to vacuum.



#### VACUUM REGULARLY

Use a quality vacuum without the beater bar setting as it can pull or snag. Shedding can be common with some new broadloom or rugs but this will lessen over time with regular vacuuming. Vacuum high traffic areas more often.



#### SPOT CLEAN AS NEEDED

Clean spills immediately by blotting with a clean, dry white cloth. For hard to remove stains we recommend the broadloom or rug be professionally cleaned. For more detailed stain removal, please visit <a href="https://www.nourison.com/cleaning">www.nourison.com/cleaning</a>



#### TAME THE SHAG

A great tip for cleaning a shag rug is to turn it upside down and vacuum the back with the beater bar setting. This will shake loose all the dirt and dust. Once done, move the rug and vacuum up all the dirt that came loose onto the floor.

#### FOR SAFETY



Rug pads hold rugs in place. A rug pad can help prevent bunching, which can lead to tripping & rug shift, which can lead to slipping. Even when a rug seems "secured" by furniture or on carpet, a rug pad adds an extra layer of protections against mishaps.

Rug pads protect the rug's weave, which can be worn by the constant pulling & tugging of foot traffic & vacuuming. A rug pad extends the life of the rug, & protects your investment.

#### FOR COMFORT




Rug pads provide extra padding, increasing comfort, insulation, & sound proofing in the home. A rug pad also provides a buffer zone for dirt & dust, keeping them off of your hard surfaces, & making them easier to vacuum away.

It is important to choose the right type of rug pad for your flooring. Hard surface rug pads can be used on hardwood, stone, tile or vinyl.


