


### **Glider Assembly**

## Connecting the glider cross brace to the glider arms

- □ Insert the right and left arms (A and B) into the cross brace (C) on both sides.
- □ Fasten them together by using M6x30 bolts (BB), d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE), and M6xP1.0 plastic nuts (GG).




NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrenches (HH and JJ).



## **2** Connecting the glider bottom frame to the glider arms

- Place the arm assembly on to the bottom frame (D).
- □ Make sure that the higher tube on the bottom frame (D) is facing the front of the glider.




## 3 Connecting the glider arms to the glider bottom frame

□ Fasten the swing bars of the arm assembly to the bottom frame (D) by using M6x55 bolts (CC), d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE), and M6xP1.0 plastic nuts (GG).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrenches (HH and JJ).




# 4 Connecting the glider seat assembly to the glider arms

□ At the front of the glider, fasten the seat assembly (E) to the arms (A and B) by using M6x16 bolts (AA) and d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (HH).




## **5** Connecting the glider seat assembly to the glider arms

□ Fasten the seat assembly (E) to the right and left arms (A and B) by using M8x35 bolts (DD) and d8.5xD17x1.6 washers (FF).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (II).



## **6** Tightening the bolts

- □ Turn the glider to its upright position.
- Once all of the bolts are in place, fully tighten the bolts.
- Ensure all connections are secure before use.



### **Care and Cleaning**

- For best results, clean the set with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- □ Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- □ Store the set in a dry, sheltered place when not in use.
- Keep the set away from fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
