

Use and Care Manual: Garden Fence

1. Product Overview

This air conditioner fence (charcoal) features 3 steel panels designed to conceal and protect outdoor AC units. Crafted from galvanized steel with a powder coating, it includes 4 uprights, 4 ground anchors, 4 aluminum foot covers, and hardware for freestanding installation. Ideal for patios, backyards, and gardens, it adds privacy, reduces noise, and enhances outdoor aesthetics.

2. Assembly Instructions

Tools Needed: Drill or screwdriver (not included).

Steps:

1. **Unpack Components:** Lay out 3 panels, 4 uprights, 4 ground anchors, 4 foot covers, and screws on a flat surface.
2. **Attach Panels to Uprights:** Align each panel with the pre-drilled holes on the uprights. Secure with screws using a drill or screwdriver (tighten until firm, but avoid over-tightening to prevent damage).
3. **Connect Panels:** Join the 3 panels together using the same method to form a 3-sided enclosure.
4. **Install Ground Anchors:** Insert the 4 ground anchors into the base of the uprights. For soft ground, gently tap anchors into the soil to stabilize the fence; for hard surfaces (concrete, patio), skip anchors and place directly.
5. **Add Foot Covers:** Slide aluminum foot covers over the base of each upright to protect against rust and enhance stability.

3. Placement Guidelines

- **Positioning:** Place the fence around 3 sides of the AC unit, leaving 2–3 feet of clearance between the fence and the unit for proper airflow (critical for AC efficiency).
- **Surface:** Works on soil, grass, concrete, or patio surfaces. For uneven ground, adjust anchor depth to level the fence.
- **Avoid Obstructions:** Ensure the fence does not block access to AC controls, vents, or maintenance areas.

4. Care & Maintenance

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the steel surface with a soft, damp cloth to remove dirt, dust, or debris. For stubborn stains, use mild soap and water (avoid abrasive cleaners, which may damage the powder coating).
- **Rust Prevention:** The galvanized steel and powder coating resist rust, but inspect annually for scratches. Touch up small chips with rust-resistant spray paint (matching charcoal color) to prevent corrosion.

- **Seasonal Checks:**
 - **Spring/Summer:** Clear any leaves, twigs, or debris trapped between the fence and AC unit to maintain airflow.
 - **Fall/Winter:** Remove snow or ice buildup from panels to prevent excess weight strain.

5. Safety Notes

- **Weight Limit:** Do not climb or lean on the fence (max weight capacity: 20 lbs per panel).
- **Wind Resistance:** In high-wind areas, reinforce with additional anchors (not included) to prevent tipping.
- **AC Access:** Keep the fence easily removable or positioned to allow technicians access for AC repairs/maintenance.

6. Troubleshooting

- **Wobbly Fence:** Tighten loose screws or adjust ground anchors for better stability.
- **Rust Spots:** Sand the affected area lightly, then apply rust-resistant paint.
- **Panel Misalignment:** Loosen screws, realign panels, and retighten to ensure a straight 3-sided enclosure.

7. Disposal

At the end of its lifespan, disassemble the fence and recycle the steel components according to local metal recycling guidelines.
