

Use and Care Manual

Installation: Roll the top sealing part of the dry bag up, making sure all openings are tightly rolled up. Secure the top seal with a buckle or zipper to ensure a tight and seamless seal.

Use: When used in wet or rainy days, ensure that the sealing of the drying bag is tightly closed to prevent moisture infiltration. In case of moisture infiltration, remove the item immediately and dry the drying bag.

Clean: If there are stains on the surface of the drying bag, gently wipe with a damp cloth and then dry. Avoid using chemical cleaners or strong acid and alkali solutions to prevent damage to the material.

Check: Check regularly whether the sealing, zipper, D-ring and other parts of the drying bag are in good condition, and replace them in time if they are damaged. If the dry bag is damaged or leaking, please stop using it immediately and contact us for repair or replacement.

Storage: When storing, please ensure that the drying bag is in a dry and ventilated environment to avoid long-term moisture or sun exposure. Do not place dry bags with sharp or heavy objects to prevent cutting or crushing.
