

Use and Care Manual for HDPE Adirondack Chairs

Cleaning and Maintenance

1. **Regular Cleaning:** Use a soft cloth or sponge with mild soap and water to clean the surface. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scrubbers, as they may scratch the material.
2. **Removing Stains:**
For stubborn stains, mix a small amount of bleach with water and apply gently with a soft brush. Rinse thoroughly with water to prevent discoloration.
3. **Protection from UV Rays:**
HDPE is UV-resistant, but prolonged exposure to sunlight can cause fading. Consider using a UV-protective cover when not in use.
4. **Winter Storage:**
If you plan to store the chairs during winter, clean them thoroughly and cover them to protect from moisture and debris.
Store in a dry place, such as a garage or shed.

Safety Guidelines

1. **Weight Limit:** Check the weight capacity of the chair, as stated by the manufacturer, and do not exceed it.
