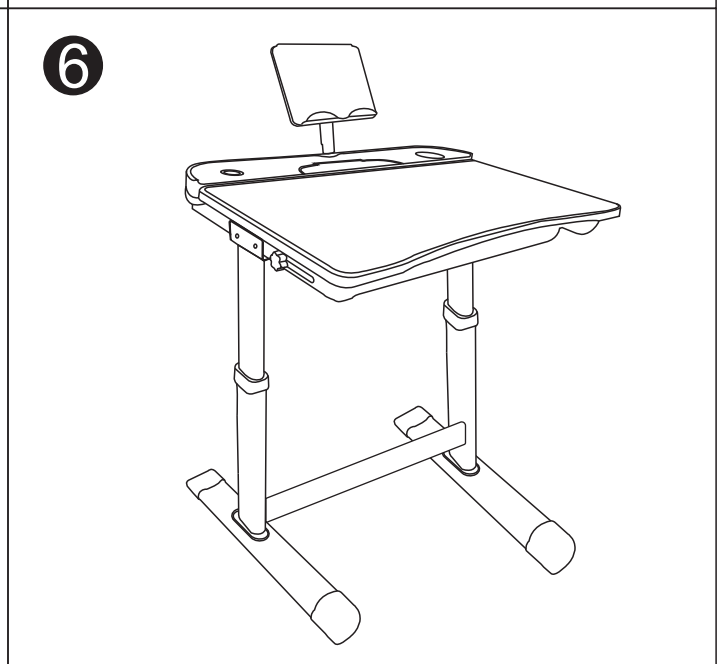
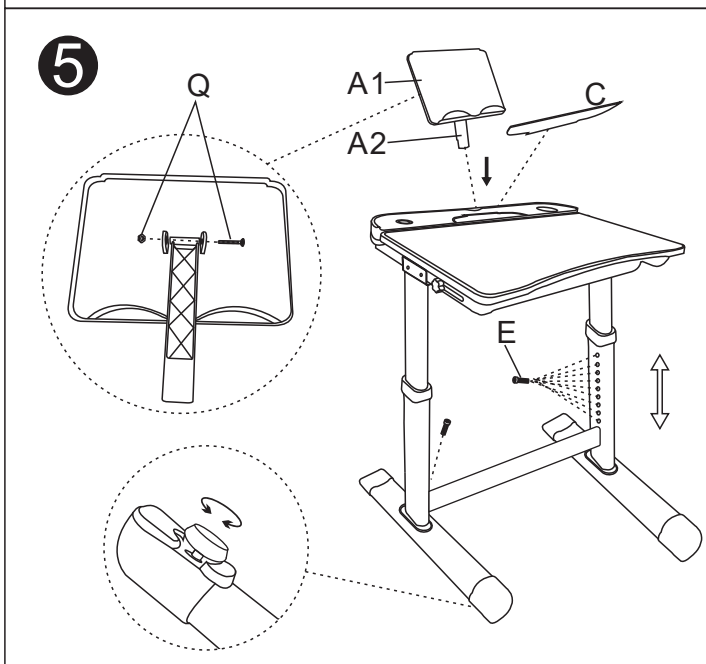
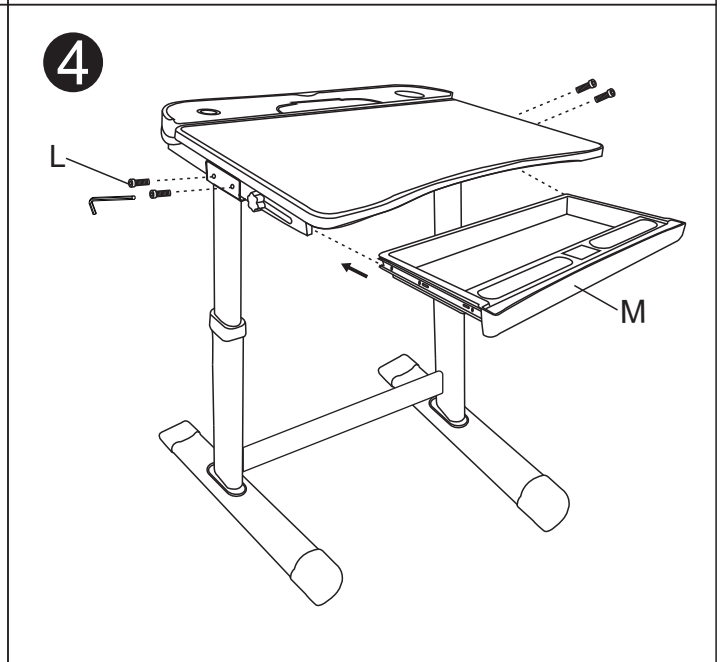
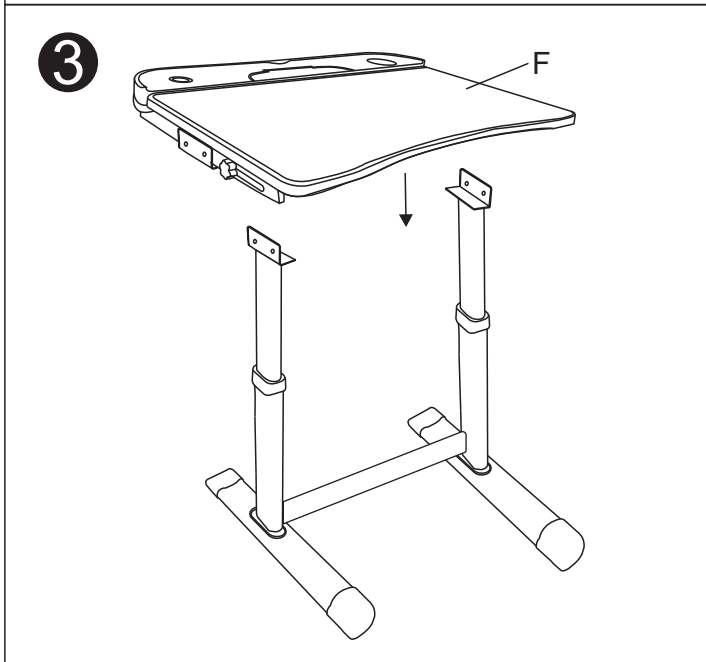
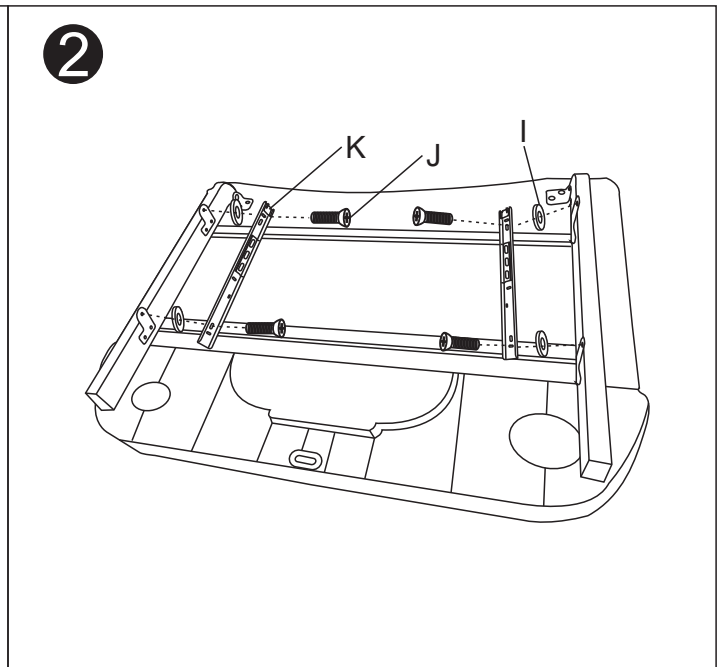
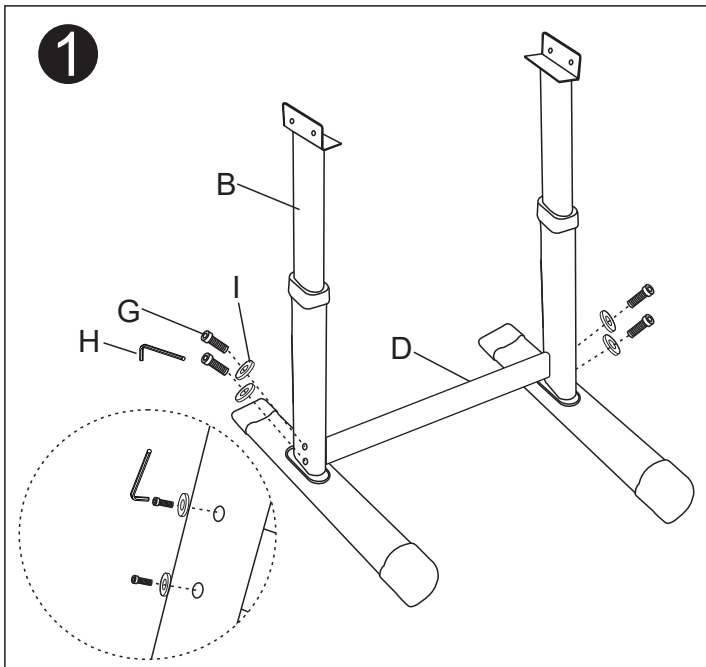


General safety and use instruction

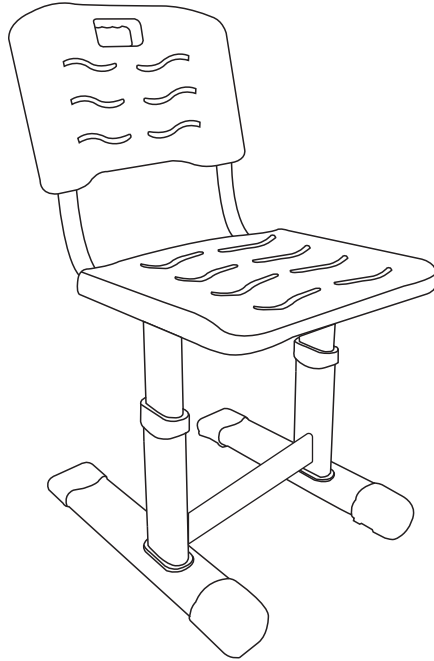
- Please make sure that your rooms are ventilated regularly.
- Very dry or very humid air will support the warping of wooden products.
- Prevent sharp and pointed objects from direct contact with the surface.
- Use a damp cloth or leather with washing up liquid or soft soap to clean the surface.
- Do not use washing powders or any other substances containing abrasives to clean the surface.
- Wipe off liquids and moist spots immediately with a soft and dry cloth.
- Do not place very hot or very cold items on the surface(s) unless adequately thick table mats are used to prevent such items from coming into contact with the desk top.
- Do not use the desk top as a chopping surface. Do not strike the desk top with hard or pointed items

Safety rules

1. Don't stand on the chair.
2. Package material take far away from children.
3. Don't let the children play on the chairs – fast rotating is so dangerous.
4. Don't put on electrical devices on upholstery.
5. Don't lean so far back in your chairs that the wheels or legs lift up off the floor.
6. Don't seat on the edge of the seat.
7. At least every 6 months inspect the chair to make sure that all the parts are tighten.

Care and maintenance

1. With regular care and maintenance, your seating will provide many years of superior performance and satisfaction.
2. Textile surfaces:
 - a. For normal cleaning, vacuum fabric as needed using an upholstery attachment, do not brush fabric or use a vacuum attachment with a rotary brush.
 - b. For stains use water-based cleaner, specifically made for cleaning fabric or a solution of mild warm soapy water applied with a damp clean cloth or sponge. Never use hot water, avoid scrubbing.
3. Leather surfaces:
 - a. For normal cleaning, use a brush with soft bristles or a dry microfibre cloth.
 - b. For spots and spills, wipe excess liquid immediately with a clean cloth or sponge, let the leather air dry, never use a hair dryer or other heat source to dry leather.
 - c. For leather surfaces never use water or water-based cleaner, use just special for leather surfaces, following the manufacturer's instructions.
4. Metal and plastic surfaces:
 - a. For normal cleaning, wash plastic or metal surfaces with a soft cloth soaked in detergent and warm water, rinse thoroughly and dry.
