

Instructions / Assembly for Upgrade Fence Privacy Screen

1. Pre-Installation Preparation

Tools Needed: Measuring tape, marker, scissors (if trimming is required), zip ties or mounting hooks (compatible with brass grommets).

Check Components: Ensure the package includes 1 × 6 ft. x 50 ft. HDPE privacy screen (with pre-installed brass grommets) – no extra hardware is needed for basic mounting.

Site Preparation: Clear the fence area of debris (e.g., branches, dirt) to ensure a flat, stable surface for installation. Measure the fence length to confirm the screen fits (trim with scissors if necessary).

2. Step-by-Step Assembly

Step 1: Position the Privacy Screen

Unroll the HDPE privacy screen along the fence. Align the top edge of the screen with the top of the fence to ensure even coverage. Use a marker to mark the location of brass grommets on the fence (grommets are spaced evenly for easy mounting).

Step 2: Secure the Screen with Grommets

Insert zip ties or mounting hooks through the brass grommets (rust-proof for long-term use) and fasten them to the fence rails. Tighten the ties/hooks slightly to keep the screen taut – avoid over-tightening to prevent tearing the reinforced edges.

Step 3: Reinforce for Stability

For extra durability (especially in windy areas), use additional zip ties at the double-support edges (located on both sides of the screen). This enhances the screen's resistance to wind and ensures it stays in place.

Step 4: Trim (If Needed)

If the screen is longer than the fence, use scissors to trim the excess material. Cut along a straight line and avoid damaging the reinforced edges or brass grommets.

3. Usage & Maintenance Tips

Privacy & Protection: Position the screen to cover the desired area – it provides 90% light shading and blocks harmful UV rays, so avoid direct contact with sharp objects that may tear the HDPE material.

Weather Resistance: The non-recyclable HDPE material withstands rain, sun, and wind, but clean the screen periodically with mild soap and water to remove dirt (do not use harsh chemicals).

Multi-Scene Application: For courtyards/gardens, mount the screen on garden fences; for construction sites, secure it to temporary barriers. Use it to calm pets by creating a private enclosure.

4. Safety Notes

Keep scissors and sharp tools away from children during installation.

Do not pull or stretch the screen excessively – it is tear-resistant but may deform under extreme force.

Check the brass grommets and fasteners monthly (especially after heavy rain/wind) to ensure they remain secure.
