INSTRUCTION GUIDE PLASTIC CLEANOUT PLUG



1	Ensure threads on cleanout are clean and free of debris.
2	Apply an approved Oatey thread sealant to the threads of the Plastic Cleanout Plug.
3	Screw the Plastic Cleanout Plug into the cleanout opening until hand tight.
4	Using a pipe wrench or adjustable split ring pliers, finish tightening the Plastic Cleanout Plug in place.
5	Test to verify that the installation of the Plastic Cleanout Plug has created a watertight seal. Run water from the nearest fixture on the same pipe run that the cleanout is located and visually inspect for leaks.
6	If a leak occurs repeat steps 1-5 until a watertight seal is achieved.
