Indoor Comfort Level Station



DRY	< 34%

The arrow marks current ambient humidity on the display from 'DRY' to 'WET' **Note:** the arrow will not be shown if the temperature is overflow ("OF.L")

Get Started

Step 1: Insert 1 x AAA, IEC LR3, 1.5V Alkaline battery according to polarity. The indoor temperature, humidity data, and the comfort level indicator will be displayed. **Note:** This station does not have a battery cover.

Restart: If the indoor temperature is not displayed after 60 seconds, remove batteries from the comfort station. Press any button 20 times. After 15 minutes, return to **Step 1** above.

MIN/MAX Button

- Press to view the MIN/MAX temperature and humidity records.
- Hold 3 seconds to reset the MIN/MAX temperature records

Fahrenheit/Celsius (°C/°F Button)

Toggle between °C and °F temperature readings.
