

SPANISH LAVENDER

Lavandula stoechas

DIFFICULTY



OVERVIEW

Features pineapple-shaped blooms with colorful bracts on each spike. Highly aromatic light green foliage. Grows as an annual in most zones. Blooms from early summer into fall. In gardens or beds, plant spaced apart to allow for air flow. Requires regular deadheading and pruning to promote healthy blooming.



WATER

Drought tolerant when established. Water infrequently but deeply. Avoid high-humidity environments.



LIGHT

Requires bright direct light. Avoid extreme temperatures.



SOIL

Requires a well-draining soil. Great for containers and borders. Attracts pollinators.
