
Sofa Assembly

THE SEAT PANEL

Attach the left arm (A) to the seat panel (C) using combination bolts (AA).



NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the box wrench (JJ) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic bolt caps (CC) after final assembly is finished.



- ☐ Attach the back panel (D) to the left arm (A) using combination bolt (AA).




3 ATTACHING THE MIDDLE LEG TO THE SEAT PANEL


4 ATTACHING THE RIGHT ARM TO THE SEAT PANEL AND THE BACK PANEL

- □ Attach the right arm (B) to the seat panel (C) using combination bolts (AA).
- □ Attach the right arm (B) to the back panel (D) using combination bolt (AA).

Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic bolt caps (CC) after final assembly is finished.




5 ATTACHING THE BACK PANEL 6 TIGHTENING THE BOLTS AND TO THE RIGHT ARM AND LEFT **ARM**

- ☐ Attach the back panel (D) to the left arm (A) using combination bolt (BB).








ADDING THE BOLT CAPS




- □ Place seat cushion (F) and back cushion (G) on the chair.

Chair Assembly

1 INSERTING THE STEEL BAR ON THE STEM BRACKET TO THE LEFT ARM

☐ Insert the steel bar on the stem bracket (L) to the left arm (H).




2 ATTACHING THE LEFT ARM TO THE STEM BRACKET

Attach the left arm (H) to the stem bracket (L) using combination bolts (DD), washers (EE) and nuts (FF).



NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the wrench (II) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic bolt caps (GG) after final assembly is finished.




Chair Assembly (continued)

3 ATTACHING THE CROSS BAR TO THE LEFT ARM

☐ Attach the cross bar (K) to the left arm (H) using combination bolts (AA).



NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the box wrench (JJ) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic bolt caps (CC) after final assembly is finished.




4 ATTACHING THE RIGHT ARM TO THE CROSS BAR AND THE STEM BRACKET

- □ Attach the right arm (I) to the cross bar (K) using combination bolts (AA).
- □ Attach the right arm (I) to the stem bracket (L) using combination bolts (DD), washers (EE) and nuts (FF).



NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the box wrench (JJ) and wrench (II) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic bolt caps (CC) and (GG) after final assembly is finished.



Chair Assembly (continued)

5 ATTACHING THE SEAT FRAME 6 TIGHTENING THE BOLTS AND TO THE STEM BRACKET

☐ Attach the seat frame (J) to the stem bracket (L) using combination bolts (HH), washers (EE) and nuts (FF).



NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the wrench (II) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic bolt caps (GG) after final assembly is finished.


ADDING THE BOLT CAPS


☐ Once all of the bolts are in place, fully tighten the bolts using the box wrench (JJ) and wrench (II).

□Install the bolt caps (CC) and (GG) to every bolt.

7 ADDING THE CUSHIONS

- ☐ Ensure all connections are secure before use.




Table Assembly

1 ATTACHING ONE TABLE LEG TO THE TABLE TOP

□ Attach one table leg (P) to the table top (O) using combination bolts (AA).



NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the box wrench (JJ) to tighten.


Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic bolt caps (CC) after final assembly is finished.

2 ATTACHING THE CROSS BAR TO THE TABLE LEG

□ Attach the cross bars (Q) to the table leg (P) using combination bolts (AA).



NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the box wrench (JJ) to tighten. Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic bolt caps (CC) after final assembly is finished.






3 ATTACHING THE OTHER TABLE LEG TO THE CROSS BAR

□ Attach the other table leg (P) to the cross bars (Q) using combination bolts (AA) and using combination bolts (BB).



NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the box wrench (JJ) to tighten.

Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic bolt caps (CC) after final assembly is finished.



4 TIGHTENING THE BOLTS AND ADDING THE BOLT CAPS

□ Once all of the bolts are in place, fully tighten the bolts using the box wrench (JJ).

□Install the bolt caps (CC) to every bolt.



NOTE: Please ensure all the bolts are assembled correctly and use the box wrench (JJ) to tighten.

Do not fully tighten bolts/screws until all pieces are loosely assembled. Add corresponding plastic bolt caps (CC) after final assembly is finished.



