

Headboard Care & Maintenance Guide

● General Care

Place the headboard away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and areas with high humidity to prevent fading, warping, or cracking.

Regularly dust with a soft, dry cloth to maintain a clean appearance.

Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or sharp tools on the surface.

● Fabric Upholstered Headboards

Vacuum regularly using a soft brush attachment to remove dust and debris.

For spills, blot immediately with a clean, dry cloth. Do not rub.

Use a mild upholstery cleaner or fabric-safe soap solution for spot cleaning. Test in an inconspicuous area first.

Avoid excessive moisture to prevent mold, mildew, or fabric damage.

● Leather or Faux Leather Headboards

Wipe with a soft, damp cloth weekly to maintain shine and cleanliness.

Use a leather conditioner every 6 – 12 months to prevent cracking or drying.

Keep away from sharp objects to avoid scratches or punctures.

● Wood Headboards

Dust frequently with a microfiber or lint-free cloth.

Clean with a slightly damp cloth followed by immediate drying.

Apply furniture polish or wood conditioner occasionally to preserve finish.

Avoid placing hot or wet items directly on the surface.

● Metal Headboards

Clean with a soft, damp cloth and mild soap as needed.

Dry thoroughly to prevent rust or water stains.

Apply a thin coat of clear furniture wax or rust-resistant spray if necessary.

- **Assembly & Stability**

Check and tighten all screws and fittings every 3 – 6 months.

Ensure the headboard remains securely attached to the bed frame or wall.

Do not exceed recommended weight capacity or use the headboard for climbing or heavy pressure.
