

FAQS – The Rebels Shady Lawn Blend

A: The best time to plant tall fescue grass seed, including Rebels Shady Lawn, is in early to mid-September. Cooler fall temperatures and increased moisture create ideal germination conditions for cool-season grasses like tall fescue. If you miss the optimal window, planting

in October is still possible with a reasonable chance of the seed surviving the upcoming winter.

8. Q: Is October too late to plant Rebels Shady Lawn grass seed?

A: Planting Rebels Shady Lawn grass seed in October is not ideal but can still be successful if done promptly. Early to mid-September is the preferred window for seeding tall fescue, as the seedlings have more time to establish before winter.
