Christmas Cactus

LIGHT

Grow Christmas cactus in bright light for the most blooms. It will grow in medium or low light, too --- but will have fewer blooms.



Water Christmas cactus when the top inch or two of the potting mix dries out.



FOOD

Feed me once or twice a year during Spring and Summer with a fertilizer formulated for houseplants.

You can find Christmas cactus in a wide variety of colors, including pink, red, scarlet, orange, gold, cream, and white.

GROWING TIPS

Christmas cactus grows best in average temperatures, but cooler temperatures around 55F (13C) can help it to produce blooms.
