

Use and Care Manual

Inspect Before Assembly: Upon receiving the folding chair, check for any damages or missing parts.

Weight Limit: Make sure not to exceed the weight capacity specified by the manufacturer to avoid structural damage.

Opening&Closing: To open the chair, hold onto the seat and gently unfold it until it locks into place. When closing, carefully fold the chair.

Use: Always use the chair on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping.

Cleaning: Clean the chair with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or steel wool that can scratch the finish. Dry thoroughly after cleaning.

Maintenance: Regularly inspect the chair for loose screws or joints and tighten them as needed.

Corrosion Prevention: If your metal folding chairs are exposed to moisture, dry them off immediately to prevent rust.

Stacking: Ensure that they are completely dry before stacking to prevent rust.

Covering: Consider using a cover or storing chairs in a dry place away from direct sunlight to protect against weathering and fading.

Avoid Long-Term Pressure Points: Do not store heavy objects on top of stacked chairs as this could cause deformation over time.

Safety Precautions: Do not stand or jump on the chair. Keep children under supervision when using the chair to prevent accidents.
