

### 3 EASY STEPS

FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS TO WOW YOUR NEIGHBORS

#### STEP 1

##### PREPARE



NEW LAWNS



OVERSEEDING

##### FOR BARE SPOTS/NEW LAWNS:

Remove debris, then rake the soil to loosen and smooth the top layer.

PARA ZONAS CON HUECOS O CÉSPED NUEVO: Quite los desechos y luego rasque la tierra para aflojar y suavizar la capa superior.

##### FOR OVERSEEDING/THIN AREAS:

Start by mowing existing grass as short as possible followed by removing debris. Then rake the soil to loosen and smooth the top layer.

Para el sobrepaseo o áreas delgadas: Comience cortando el césped existente lo más corto posible y eliminando los desechos. Luego, rasque la tierra para aflojar y suavizar la capa superior.

#### STEP 2

##### APPLY



Spread the seed evenly using a drop, rotary or hand-held spreader according to the recommended spreader settings listed. Rake gently to work your seed & fertilizer into the soil.

Aplicación: Distribuya las semillas de manera uniforme con un esparcedor de caída, rotatorio o manual, de acuerdo con las configuraciones recomendadas y enumeradas del esparcedor. Rasque suavemente para que las semillas y el fertilizante germinen en la tierra.

#### STEP 3

##### WATER



Keep the soil moist by watering daily as needed until grass sprouts and reaches about 3" tall.

Regar: Mantenga la tierra húmeda al regar lo que sea necesario por 6-8 veces por día después de sembrar y durante el desarrollo de 3 pulgadas (7.62 cm) de alto.

#### ADDITIONAL CARE TIPS

- 1 Mow lawn when grass height reaches 3" tall
- 2 Avoid removing more than 1/3 of the total grass blade length in any single mowing
- 3 Hot summers can be stressful on your lawn, increase the mowing height during hot and dry periods to reduce stress on your lawn



**MOST IMPORTANTLY - Don't kill the grass before it starts by using weed control (gras call it preemergent) on your lawn until your grass has reached its full mowing height of 3"**

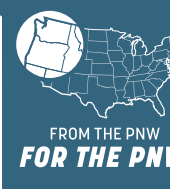

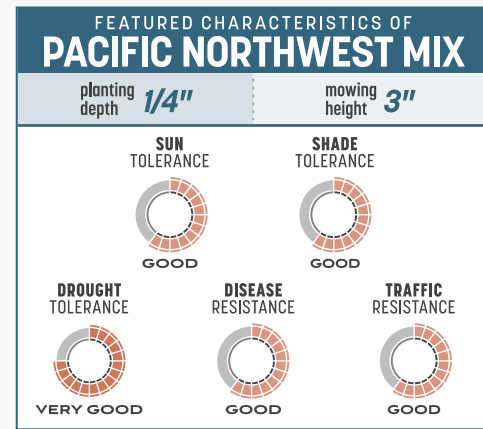

NOTICE: Arbitration/mediation/mediation required by several states. Under the seed laws of several states, arbitration, mediation, or conciliation is required as a prerequisite to maintaining a legal action based upon the failure of seed, in which the parties are required to produce an expert. The consumer shall file a complaint with the required filing fee with the commissioner of the state secretary of agriculture, seed commissioner, or chief agricultural officer within such time as permit inspection of the crop by the designated expert on the seedman from whom the seed was purchased. A copy of the complaint shall be sent to the seller by certified or registered mail or otherwise provided by state statute.
