

Artificial Turf Installation Guide

- Preparing the Area
 - Remove at least 2 inches of your existing lawn/base
- 2. Creating a Base
 - Evenly spread 4 inches of road base for a level foundation with proper drainage. Wet the area and flatten with a compactor
- 3. Laying out Turf
 - Roll out your ColourTree artificial turf and let it sit for an hour for it to unfurl
- 4. Cutting to Size
 - With your turf on the desired area, you may cutting to fit your area perfectly.
 Cut from the back and leave 1/4" to 1/2" of turf extra when cutting for the next step
- 5. Securing the Turf
 - Tuck the 1/4" to 1/2" edge into the border with a putty knife and hammer and drive your staples into the ground every 6 inches along the perimeter and every 2 feet inside the area
- Applying Filler
 - Brush up the turf to keep the blade memory vertical before spreading infill.
 Using a drop spreader, use one or a mixture of: Zeolite, Crumb Rubber, Silica
 Sand, and Acrylic Coated Sand

Final Groom

a) Complete one final brush up with a stiff-bristle broom or power broom
