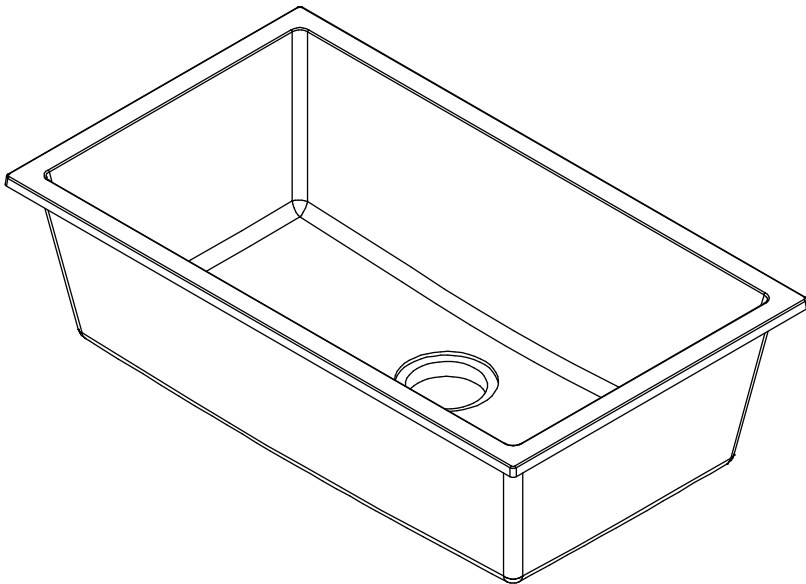


Dual Mount Installation Sink



Use and Care Manual

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION

Due to the weight of the sink, exercise caution when handling, moving or lifting the box or the sink. Use safety gloves and protective gear for eyes and ears. Get assistance when lifting or mounting the sink at any time during the installation procedure. DO NOT attempt to handle or install this product if doing so post a risk of bodily injury or you are medically unfit to carry out the installation.

IMPORTANT: recommends that this product be installed by a licensed plumber. Ensure that installation complies with applicable plumbing and building codes.

TOOLS

Safety glasses / maker / silicone adhesive sealant / tape measure /
Jigsaw / rags / wood braces / level / screws / bladed screwdriver

ATTENTION

Read these instructions thoroughly before installation.

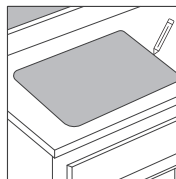
1. Check all the matching products inside when opening the package.
2. Inspect your sink for any noticeable damage before installation.
3. Consult your cabinet dealer before custom order cabinet for the sink.
4. This sink is dual mount installation. You can choose the installation type you prefer.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

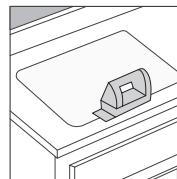
1. Undermount installation

1. Check the cut-out template against the actual sink to ensure a proper sized cut-out, then Place the cut-out template in the desired location on the countertop. Trace the cutout template with pencil accordingly.

2. Cut the opening in the countertop by carefully following the traced line. Please use the appropriate saw that best fits your countertop material.

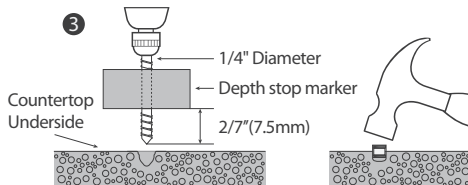

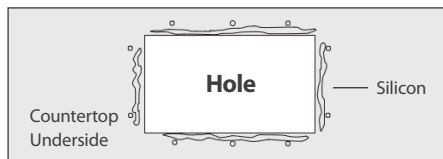

3. Drill Hole in Countertop. Turn the countertop over and drill 1/4" diameter x 2/7" deep hole in the countertop, mounting holes should be 1/2" from edge of the sink. Insert anchors into drilled holes and lightly tap with a hammer until flush.

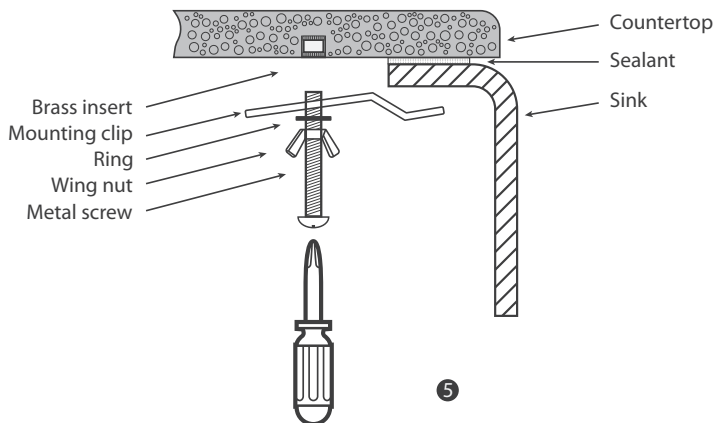
4. Secure Sink to Countertop. Use a bead of silicone (or preferred adhesive) around the rim of the sink/countertop underside. Check the alignment of the sink to the cutout in the countertop. Place sink over cutout hole and press firmly.



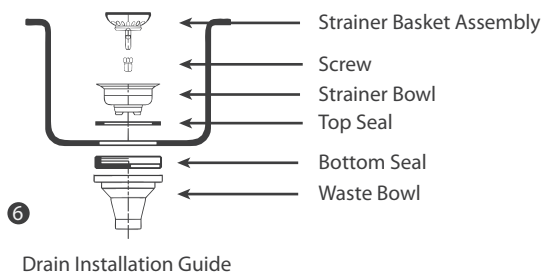

5. Attach Mounting Hardware to Secure Bowl. Remove excess sealant from inside lip. Allow sealant to set for 30 – 60 minutes.



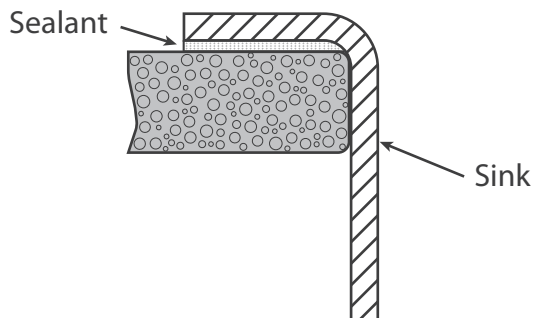
6. Install plumbing fixtures to the sink according to manufacturer's instructions. Drain the water into the sink and check for leaks.

2. Drop in installation

1. Check the cut-out template against the actual sink to ensure a proper sized cut-out, then Place the cut-out template in the desired location on the countertop. Trace the cutout template with pencil accordingly.
2. Carefully cut the opening in the countertop according to the tracing line (Note: use the saw suitable for cutting the material of your countertop)
3. Clean and dry the rim surface of the sink; turn the sink upside down and apply the sealant(not included) underneath the sink rim.
4. Insert the sink into the opening, confirm that the sink fits the countertop opening, and press firmly.
5. Remove excess silicone-based adhesive, then allow the sealant to settle for 30-60 minutes.
6. Install plumbing fixtures to the sink according to manufacturer's instructions. Drain water into the sink and check for leaks.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

DO

1. Clean daily and keep the sink dry after you use it. Because any standing water can cause a build-up of mineral deposits, which will become hard water stains.
2. Use a soft towel or sponge to clean the sink with warm water. Mixing in some washer-fluid is advisable. Wipe the sink dry after cleaning.
3. Rinse the sink after using any cleaning agent and wipe dry. If any mineral deposits built the sink, clean up it as soon as possible.
4. Use a bottom basin rack to help protect your sink surface.

DO NOT

1. Leave cleaning agents or bleach in your sink which may cause the sink to discolor or damage the surface.
2. Place extremely hot kitchenware directly on the surface of the sink as this can cause damage.
3. Use cleaners that are abrasive or containing bleach.
4. Use abrasive cleaning materials to wipe the surface of the sink, such as steel wool or scouring pad.
5. Use the inside of the sink as cutting surface.

TIPS

Scratch Marks & Discoloration

Granite sinks may become discolored or scratched - unless you protect them properly. To avoid these problems, you should prevent placing hot objects directly on the surface of the sink for a long time or scratching the surface with sharp objects. You can use a bottom basin rack to help protect your sink surface.

Food Stains & Water Marks

Water stays in the sink for a long time and is not wiped clean after each use will cause water stains. To remove these stains you can use a soft cloth with detergent to gently wipe them away. Make it a habit to clean it daily and dry the sink after cleaning.

- This warranty does not apply unless the product is installed by a fully insured and licensed trade professional.
- This warranty does not cover damage caused by environmental factors, normal wear including dents and scratches.
- This warranty does not cover damage caused by improper care and cleaning including the use of aggressive cleaning agents and abrasive cleaning materials.
- This warranty does not cover shipping costs, labor costs, or any other charges for such items as installation or replacement of the sink, diagnosis or replacement of any component part, or any other expense or loss.
- This warranty does not cover marine or outdoor Installation.
- This warranty does not cover Installation in violation of applicable state or local plumbing or housing codes.
