Can I use Goof Off® Pro Strength Remover on my car without harming the topcoat?

Goof Off® Professional is not recommended for painted automotive surfaces.

Can I use Goof Off® Pro Strength to remove ink, gum, crayon, etc., from inside my washer/dryer?

Goof Off® Pro Strength is flammable and is not recommended for use inside a dryer.

Can I use Goof Off® Pro Strength Remover on my microwave to remove sticker residue?

Goof Off® Pro Strength is flammable and is not recommended for use inside a microwave.

Can I use Goof Off® Pro Strength Remover on leather?

No. Goof Off® Professional works best on hard surfaces, such as metal, glass, brick, wood, concrete, grout, fiberglass, hand tools, and automotive surfaces.

Can I use Goof Off® Pro Strength on Vinyl Siding?

Goof Off® Professional is safe on some vinyl materials. Always try Goof Off® Pro Strength Remover in an inconspicuous test area first, as it can damage many synthetic surfaces.

How do I remove the Goof Off® Pro Strength residue?

Goof Off® Pro Strength Remover evaporates quickly and does not leave a residue. If there appears to be a residue reapply the Goof Off® Pro with a rag and rub the surface until clean.

Can I use Goof Off® Pro Strength Remover on a hardwood floor or finished wood furniture?

We recommend using Goof Off® Paint Splatter Remover for Hardwoods.
