

Sofa Care & Maintenance Guide

To keep your sofa looking its best and extend its lifespan, please follow these general care instructions:

1. Regular Cleaning

Vacuum Weekly: Use a soft brush attachment to remove dust, crumbs, and pet hair from the surface and crevices.

Spot Clean Immediately: Blot spills with a clean, dry cloth. Avoid rubbing, which may spread the stain.

Mild Detergent Use: For fabric upholstery, use a small amount of mild soap mixed with water. Test in an inconspicuous area first.

2. Fabric Care

Avoid Direct Sunlight: Prolonged exposure may cause fading or fabric deterioration.

Rotate Cushions: Flip and rotate seat and back cushions regularly to maintain shape and even wear.

Pillow Fluffing: Gently fluff throw pillows to restore volume and comfort.

3. Frame & Structure

Avoid Jumping or Standing: This may damage the frame or deform the cushions.

Check Bolts & Joints: Periodically inspect and tighten screws or bolts to ensure stability.

4. Environmental Factors

Maintain Proper Humidity: Extremely dry or humid conditions may affect frame or fabric durability.

Keep Away from Heat Sources: Avoid placing the sofa near radiators, fireplaces, or heating vents.

5. Professional Cleaning

Annual Deep Cleaning: Consider professional upholstery cleaning at least once a year for thorough maintenance.
