

# Solar-Powered Light Use and Care Manual

## USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

- **Initial Setup:** Before first use, place the solar panel under direct sunlight for 4-6 hours to fully charge. Use the remote or manual switch to turn on the light and select brightness levels, timer settings (2/4/6 hours), or working modes (night-only or 24-hour).
- **Location:** Install the panel in an area with at least 6 hours of daily sunlight. For indoor use, keep the light near a window or connect the panel outdoors.

## MAINTENANCE TIPS

- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe the solar panel and light fixture with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust, dirt, and debris, ensuring maximum sunlight absorption.
- **Battery Life:** Although battery-free, if using a remote, replace its 2 AAA batteries when control weakens.
- **Weather Precautions:** In extreme weather (heavy snow, storms), consider temporarily removing outdoor lights to prevent damage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Dim or No Light:** Check if the panel is dirty or shaded. Ensure it's properly connected to the light and switch it on/off to reset.
