

Care and Cleaning Recommendations

General

- Arrange your furniture with the environment in mind. Protect your upholstery from sunlight, excessive humidity and dryness by carefully choosing where your furniture will be placed.
- Vacuum your furniture regularly using a soft brush attachment.
- Blot spills immediately with a clean dry white cloth. If the spill becomes a stain, check the fabric's cleaning instructions.
- Furniture is for living, however, two common things can significantly decrease the lifespan of your upholstery fabric and are strongly discouraged:
 1. Allowing pets on the furniture.
 2. Placing newspaper on the furniture.

Cushions, Backs, and Throw Pillows

- On available models, reverse all seat cushions and back pillows regularly. The cushions should also be rotated from side to side where possible.
- Back and throw pillows should be fluffed regularly to maintain full appearance and total comfort.
- Remove the cores for seats, backs, and throw pillows where applicable before any cleaning.
- Do not wash or dry cushion, back or throw pillow cores ... this will cause melting and bonding of the fibers.

Cleaning.

1. Most spills should come right out if cleaned immediately. Remove as much surface stain as possible with a soft tissue or cloth. Be careful not to spread the stain.
2. Using a mixture of mild dishwashing soap, diluted about 20 parts water to 1 part soap, apply a small amount of liquid to the stain. Wait about three minutes, then rub with a soft cloth in a circular motion until the stain is removed.
3. Using water and a clean cloth, remove the soap. Pat the area dry with a soft cloth or air dry.
4. Brush the area in the direction of the nap to return the surface to its original condition.

Note: *Do not* use solvents, bleach, or cleaners with high PH solutions, as they will permanently discolor the fabric.

Helpful Hints

- Vacuum the fabric prior to cleaning.
- Minimize spread of the stain to the surrounding clean fibers.
- Do not be alarmed if stain is not removed after first application and removal of cleaning solution.
- Do not use a stiff brush that may abrade fabric.
- Rinse thoroughly.
