1. Leather Furniture:

- (1) Use a soft dry cloth or vacuum cleaner to remove dust on the surface of leather furniture. Avoid using brushes or rough objects to wipe.
- (2) Regularly spray professional leather cleaner on a clean cloth, gently wipe the surface of the leather furniture, and then dry it with a dry cloth.
- (3) Avoid direct sunlight and high temperature environment to avoid hardening and cracking of the leather.

2. Fabric Furniture:

- (1) Use a vacuum cleaner with a furniture brush head for regular cleaning to remove dust and fine stains.
- (2) For non-removable fabric sets, it is recommended to take them out to dry outdoors regularly to eliminate bacteria and odors.
- (3) For furniture with high cloth surface permeability, protective agents can be purchased and sprayed to improve the anti-fouling performance of the furniture.

3. Common Problems and Solutions:

- (1) Oil stains or beverage stains: First use a dry cloth or absorbent paper to absorb as much of the stain as possible, then use a damp cloth dipped in a small amount of neutral detergent to wipe it gently, and finally wipe it off with a dry cloth.
- (2) Rust stains: You can use a small amount of lemon juice or white vinegar, dip it into the rust stains, wipe it gently for a few minutes, and then wipe it dry with a damp cloth.
