DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE PRECAUTIONS:

- Contact with Poison Oak or Poison Ivy anytime of the year can cause an allergic reaction. Handle dead plants with rubber gloves. Dispose of plants and rubber gloves in tightly sealed garbage bags.
- Bare spots can be planted with grass seed 1 week after application.
- Newly seeded lawn can be sprayed after second mowing.
- If an ornamental shrub or tree is in the lawn, keep spray off foliage and exposed roots.
- Avoid mowing 1 to 2 days after application.
- If lawn needs watering, water thoroughly before application.
- Rain or watering 6 hours after application will not wash away effectiveness.

USE RESTRICTIONS:

- Do not enter or allow people or pets to enter  treated areas until spray has dried.
- Do not use on Bahiagrass, Bermudagrass, Centipedegrass, Kikuyugrass or St. Augustinegrass lawns.
- Do not use on or around fruits, vegetables or flowers. If an ornamental shrub or tree is in the lawn, keep spray off foliage and exposed roots.
- Do not use on or around edible feed or food crops or areas where grazing is allowed.
- Do not make applications if air temperature is above 90°F.

- Reapplication can be made in 2 to 3 weeks if necessary, however, do not apply more than 5.4 fl oz product per 100 sq. ft. in a year from all applications.
- Apply when air is calm to prevent drift to desirable plants. Do not apply when wind exceeds 10 mph on average or if wind is gusting.

APPLICATION RESTRICTIONS:

- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift.
- Keep people and pets out of the area during application.

HOW IT WORKS

Ortho® Weed B Gon® Chickweed, Clover & Oxalis Killer for Lawns Concentrate contains a proven weed killer that targets lawn weeds. This herbicide enters the lawn weeds through their leaves and moves throughout the plant to provide control.

WHERE TO USE

This product can be applied to residential lawns with the following turfgrass types: Buffalograss, Fescues, Kentucky Bluegrass, Ryegrass and Zoysiagrass.

HOW MUCH TO USE

1 fl. oz. for 200 square feet.

WHEN TO USE

Apply when weeds are actively growing.

WEEDS CONTROLLED

Bindweed, Black Medic, Carolina Geranium, Chickweed (Common), Chickweed (Mouseear), Cinquefoil, Clover (Red), Clover (White), Dandelion, Evening Primrose, Florida Pusley, Ground Ivy (Creeping Charlie), Ironweed, Lambsquarters, Lespedeza, Morning Glory, Oxalis, Pennywort, Plantain (Broadleaf), Plantain (Buckhorn), Poison Ivy, Red Sorrel, Speedwell (Veronica), Spurge (Garden), Spurge (Spotted), Thistle and Wild Violet.

HOW TO USE

Tank Sprayer: • Add 1 fl. oz. per gallon of water for each 200 sq. ft.

Ortho® Dial 'N Spray®:

Set:
• Turn dial to 1 oz.

Fill:
• Pour concentrate into sprayer jar. • Turn sprayer nozzle to preferred spray.
• Do NOT add water.

Spray:
• Connect hose to sprayer. • Turn on water. • Press and hold trigger for continuous spray. • Spray only until the surface of the weed is wet.

Finish:
• Pour unused concentrate back into its original container. • To clean: refer to the Ortho® Dial 'N Spray® cleaning instructions.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate food or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage:	Store this product in its original container and keep out of reach of children and domestic animals.
