



Dcolora Stainless Steel Sink Care Guide

Daily Care

Rinse the sink thoroughly after each use and wipe it dry with a soft cloth to prevent water spots or mineral deposits. Use a mild dish soap and warm water for regular cleaning. Avoid leaving steel cookware or wet sponges in the sink for extended periods.

Deep Cleaning

Once a week, clean your sink with a non-abrasive stainless steel cleaner or baking soda paste to remove any buildup or discoloration. Always rub in the direction of the steel grain to preserve the natural finish.

Things to Avoid

Do not use steel wool, wire brushes, or harsh chemicals like bleach and ammonia, as these can scratch or damage the finish. Avoid dropping heavy pots or sharp objects into the sink to prevent dents and scratches.
