

OPERATION

- Plug into a 12V power source, such an automobile cigarette lighter socket. Make sure your socket is rated at 15A or higher.
- Turn ignition to the "accessory" position. If you plan on using the vacuum for more than 15 minutes, you may want to run your engine to avoid draining your battery (be sure you are parked in a well-ventilated area).
- 3. Turn off all other electrical equipment in the car.
- 4. Push the power switch to the ON position and begin vacuuming.
- ▲ Do not vacuum liquids or burning objects
- A Do not cover either of the side air vents while using

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- To empty the vacuum, press the dust bin latch and separate dust bin from motor unit.
- 2. Carefully remove the filter from dust bin and discard contents.
- 3. To clean the filters, hand-wash with mild soap and water.
- The motor unit can be wiped with a damp sponge. Do not use detergents, cleaners, or solvents.
- 5. Allow all parts to dry completely before reassembling the vacuum.
- 6. For replacement filters, visit www.wagan.com
- ▲ Do not submerge the motor unit
- A Do not use when the filter is wet
- A Do not run the vacuum without the filter in place
