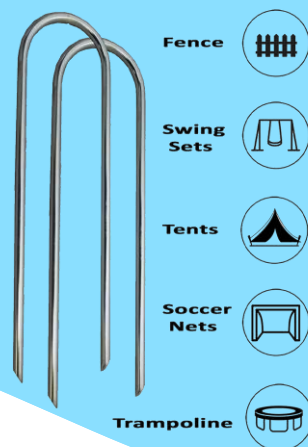




Instruction and Maintenance Guide Trampoline Stakes Safety Ground Anchors
