LIGHT

I grow best in a bright, sunny spot. I prefer at least six hours of indirect sun a day.



WATER

Water me when the top couple inches into the soil are dry, I prefer above average humidity levels. As I age, I can become drought-tolerant.



FOOD

Feed me with a slow-release granular fertilizer every six months or so.



FEATURES

I have fluffy plumes of foliage hence the name! These plumes can also help purify the air.

GROWING TIPS

If you live in a cold climate and you want to save your palms for the winter, you can bring them indoors before the first frost. In spring, move them back outdoors after all danger of frost has passed.
