## HERE'S HOW TO TAKE CARE OF ME

## Snake Plant



### LIGHT

I tolerate low light well, but will grow best in bright spots. I will grow more slowly and may show less coloration in low light.



### WATER

I like to be kept dry, I may only need watering once every two weeks. If in doubt, its best to stay on the drier side.



### FOOD

Feed me once or twice a year during Spring and Summer with a fertilizer formulated for houseplants.



### FEATURES

Not only am I super easy to grow, I am drought-tolerant and purify the air.
