

The manufacturer warrants this lighting fixture to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for one year from date of purchase. This warranty applies only to the original consumer purchaser and only to products used in normal use and service. If this product is found to be defective, the manufacturer's only obligation, and your exclusive remedy, is the repair or replacement of the product at the manufacturer's discretion, provided that the product has not been damaged through misuse, abuse, accident, modifications, alterations, neglect, or mishandling. This warranty shall not apply to any product that is found to have been improperly installed, set-up, or used in any way not in accordance with the instructions supplied with the product. This warranty shall not apply to a failure of the product as a result of an accident, misuse, abuse, negligence, alteration, faulty installation, or any other failure not relating to faulty material or workmanship. This warranty shall not apply to the finish on any portion of the product, such as surface and/or weathering, as this is considered normal wear and tear. The manufacturer does not warrant and specially disclaims any warranty, whether express or implied, of fitness for a particular purpose, other than the warranty contained herein. The manufacturer specifically disclaims any liability and shall not be liable for any consequential or incidental loss or damage, including but not limited to any labor / expense costs involved in the replacement or repair of said product.




PLANNING INSTALLATION

- ☐ To avoid damaging this product, assemble it on a soft, non-abrasive surface, such as carp et or cardboard.
- ☐ Keep your receipt and these instructions for proof of purchase.

Operation

Turning the light on

☐ Turn the light switch on to activate the fixture.

Care and Cleaning

Ш	Clean the lamp with a soft, dry cloth.	
	Do not use any cleaners with chemicals, solvents, or harsh abrasives.	
	When the product is placed on a live tree, the tree should be well maintained and fresh. Do not place on live trees in which the needles are brown or break off easily. Keep the tree holder filled with water.	
	If the product is placed on a tree, the tree should be well secured and stable.	
	Before using or reusing, inspect product carefully. Discard any products that have cut, damaged or frayed wire insulation or cords, cracks in the lampholders or enclosures, loose connections, or exposed copper wire.	
	When storing the product, carefully remove the product from wherever it is placed, including tree, branches, or bushes, to avoid a undue strain or stress on the product conductors, connections, and wires.	
П	When not in use, store neatly in a cool, dry location protected from sunlight.	

User Servicing Instructions

Replace the fuse:

- 1. Grasp plug and remove from the receptacle or other outlet device. Do not unplug by pulling on cord.
- 2. Open fuse cover. Slide open fuse access cover on top of attachment plug towards blades.
- 3. Remove fuse carefully.
- 4. Risk of fire. Replace fuse only with 5 Amp, 125 Volt fuse (provided with product).
- 5. Close fuse cover. Slide closed the fuse access cover on top of attachment plug.
- 6. Risk of fire. Do not replace attachment plug. Contains a safety device (fuse) that should not be removed.

DISCARD PRODUCT IF THE ATTACHMENT PLUG IS DAMAGED.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
The bulb will not light.	The bulb is burned out.	Replace the light bulb.
	The power is off.	Ensure the power supply is On.
	There is a faulty wire connection.	Check the wiring.
	The circuit breaker is off.	Ensure the circuit breaker is in the On position.
The fuse blows or circuit breaker trips when the light is turned on.	There are crossed wires or the power wire is grounding out.	Check the wire connections. Contact a qualified electrician or call the Customer Service Team at 1-855-HD-HAMPTON
