


# 1 POSITION SHADE

- Measure Bracket Placement to desired mounting location, mark holes for each bracket with a pencil. Pre-Drill Mounting Holes with a Drill and 1/16in Drill Bit.
- □ Outside Mounting (Fig. A).
- □ Top Mounting (Fig. B).
- □ Inside Mounting (Fig. C).




### 2 INSTALL BRACKETS


- Secure Mounting Brackets (A) with Phillips Head Screw Driver using Bracket Screws (D).
- □ Outside Mounting (Fig. D).
- □ Top Mounting (Fig. E).
- □ Inside Mounting (Fig. F).




#### 3 BRACKET ORIENTATION

- □ Inside Mounting (Fig. I).









## 4 INSTALLING HEADRAIL


☐ Line the Shades with the Mounting Brackets (A). Secure the Shades with the Washers (B), and Wing Nuts (C) to Finish the Installation.





## 5 OPERATING THE SHADE

- □ To Lower the Shade: Pull down from the center of the Bottom Rail and release at desired Shade height
- □ To Raise the Shade: Push up from the center of the Bottom Rail and release at desired Shade height
