What's in the Box

Please verify you have all parts before starting:

Main Flagpole (Longest tube)

Leg Poles (2x Shorter tubes with pointed feet)

Flag Clip Assembly (Clip with strap and hook-and-loop fastener)

Rubber Stopper

Instruction Sheet

Assembly Steps

Step A: Connect the Legs

Take the two Leg Poles. Screw the threaded end of one leg firmly into the socket of the other leg by turning it clockwise. Hand-tighten fully to form a secure 'V'-shaped base.

Step B: Attach the Main Pole

Take the Main Flagpole. Screw its threaded end into the remaining socket at the top of the 'V' base. Hand-tighten it clockwise until it is snug and the assembly feels rigid.

Step C: Attach the Flag

Slide your garden flag onto the Main Flagpole. Position the rubber stopper on the pole above the top edge of the flag to prevent it from sliding down.

Step D: Secure the Flag

Wrap the strap of the Flag Clip around the flag and pole. Adjust for a snug fit and press the hook-and-loop fastener firmly together to secure the flag in place.

Placement Tips

For best stability, push the pointed feet fully into the ground in your desired location. A gentle rocking motion can help start the insertion in firm soil.

Care & Maintenance

Wipe clean with a dry or damp cloth. Ensure the pole is dry before storing. Periodically check tightness of the connections.
