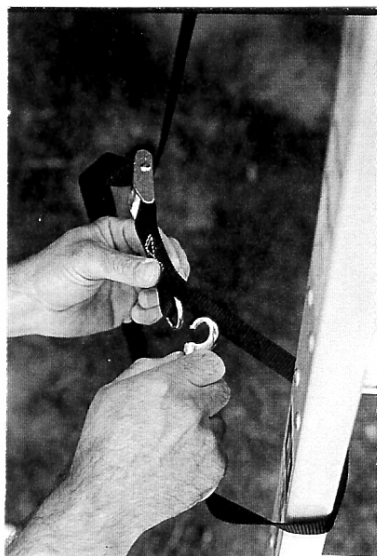

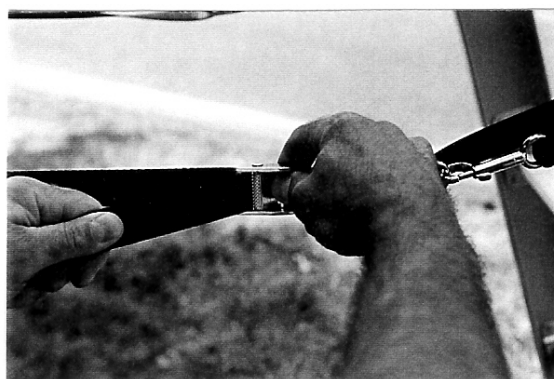

Ladder Safety Strap Model - LSS-150

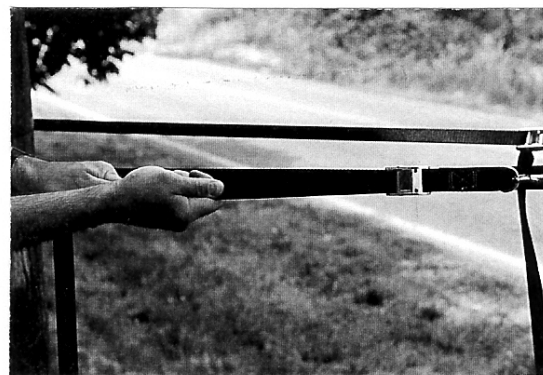
The LSS-150 is designed to eliminate the danger of potential kickout or excessive rocking of a ladder when positioned against a telephone pole or tree. This product consists of a long, durable strap with easy to use snap rings and cam buckles. It can be cinched down and completely set up in "less than a minute."



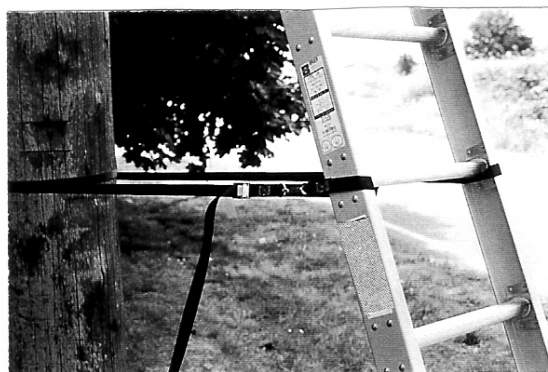
STEP 1 - Loop snap buckle around ladder rail between 4th and 5th ladder rung and clip it.



STEP 2 - Press Buckle lever and gently snug up both sides.

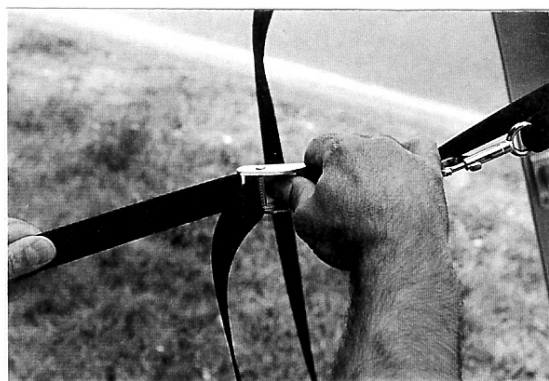


STEP 3 - Tighten both sides equally by pulling the free end of the strap back towards pole or tree.



INSPECTION OF SET UP

Be sure strap has been wrapped one complete turn around pole or tree. Once the strap is securely tightened, check the security of the system by climbing to the 4th rung and applying a slight twist to be sure the ladder base is stable. When properly tightened, side rail movement should not exceed 3 inches. If not stable, retighten at buckles and repeat inspection.



TAKE DOWN

To remove, simply press lever on buckle, loosen strap and unclip snaphook.
