

METAL GARMENT RACK INSTRUCTION

Assembly Steps:

Discard the protective covers. These are used to separate the shelves for shipping purposes.

1 Screw Leveling Feet (M) into the bottom of the Lower Poles (E). Snap one pair of Plastic Clips (L) on the same grooves of each lower pole. Make sure the arrow of all plastic clips should be pointed up, and the grooves of plastic clips should be locked with the poles.

2 Please make sure that you have the Wire Shelf (A) the correct way up. Hold the shelf on its side and slide it from the top of four lower poles down onto the plastic clips until there is snug fit.

3 Refer to Step ①,② to snap the plastic clips on the same grooves of other four lower poles and assemble the second wire shelf. And then set the rack upright.

4 According to the instruction of the photo, snap plastic clips onto the same grooves of the proper four lower poles at your desired position for the third wire shelf. Slide the third wire shelf from the top of these four lower poles down onto the plastic clips.

5 Screw Middle Poles (F) into lower poles by connectors which are already assembled on the middle poles. And screw Upper Poles (G) into middle poles by connectors which are already assembled on the upper poles.

6 Refer to Step1,2 to snap plastic clips onto the same grooves of the four poles on the left of the rack and assemble two pcs Support Rail(N) as the photo. Snap plastic clips onto the same grooves of the four poles on the right of the rack and assemble the two Left Guide Rais(C)and Right Guide Rails (D) as well.

7 Reference the above step to assem the Hook hanger (O)on the one of side then assemble the top shelf.

8 Connect the three Clothes Hanger Rods (H) respectively onto the the upper middle and top large shelves at their frames by Hook Bracket (I) and Screw (J). Similarly, hang the last clothes hanger rod directly onto the middle wire shelf of the rack at its frame. Assemble the two Wire Baskets (B) onto the the left and right guide rails by Screw Nuts (K) according to the instruction of the photo. Adjust the screw to make it fastened. Pushing firmly down on every shelf at corners by rubber mallet to ensure all the shelves in a place over the plastic clips. Screw leveling feet in or out to attain proper leveling. Now the garment rack is already completely assembled.
