Goof Off<sup>®</sup> Heavy Duty Remover is formulated for and safe for use on plastics and fabric. Always test in an inconspicuous area before broad application.

## Are Goof Off<sup>®</sup> Heavy Duty Remover safe for automobile windows?

Yes, but always test a small, inconspicuous area first to check for compatibility (not compatible with some aftermarket tint jobs).

## Can I use Goof Off® Heavy Duty on carpet?

Yes, but we recommend Goof Off<sup>®</sup> Paint Remover for Carpet, which is made specifically for carpet fibers.

## Can I use Goof Off® Heavy Duty on clothing?

Yes, Goof Off® Heavy Duty Remover is formulated for use on clothing.

## Can I use Goof Off<sup>®</sup> Heavy Duty on an automobile finish?

Goof Off® is formulated specifically for plastic and fabric. Outside of these materials, we recommend testing it on a small area first.

#### Will Goof Off® Heavy Duty remove latex paint?

We recommend Goof Off® Pro Strength Remover for dried latex paint messes.

## I need to remove gum/glue/ink/marker from a dryer. Can I use Goof Off® Heavy Duty?

Yes, the primary ingredient is not flammable or combustible.

#### Can I use Goof Off<sup>®</sup> Heavy Duty on granite or marble countertops?

Yes, but always test the product in a small, inconspicuous spot prior to broad application.

#### Can I use Goof Off® Heavy Duty on leather car seats to remove ink/glue?

Goof Off® Heavy Duty Remover is ideal for most fabrics, but we do not recommend use on leather.

#### Is it safe to use Goof Off® Heavy Duty on acrylic plastics?
