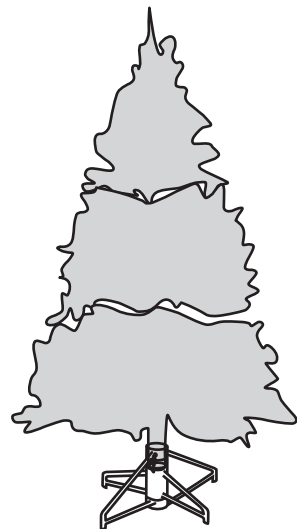

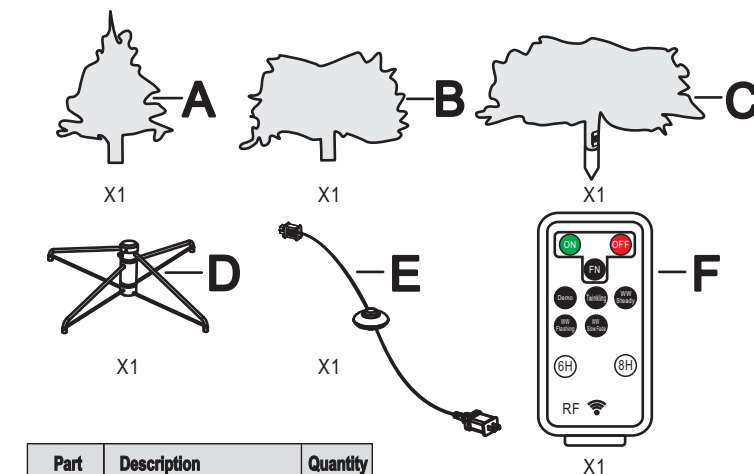

Pre-Assembly

PLANNING ASSEMBLY

Carefully remove all the parts from the box, and place them on a flat surface. Read the entire manual prior to assembly, and identify all the parts included in the package against the parts list. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not attempt assembly, but contact our customer service center.

Assembly

1 Assembling the tree stand

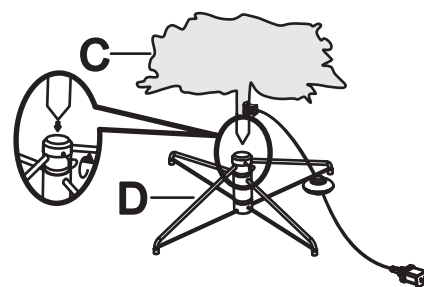
- Choose a location near a wall outlet.
- Open the stand to a 90 degree angle until the hole lines up with the hole on the tube.
- Screw an eye bolt into the hole.

2 Assembling the tree

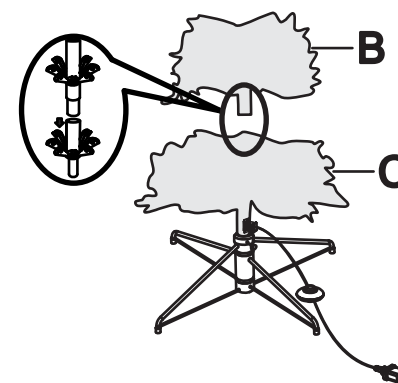
- Please remove protective covers from the base of the pole for each tree section before assembling.
- Carefully insert bottom section (C) of tree into tree base and tighten the screw.

3 Assembling the tree

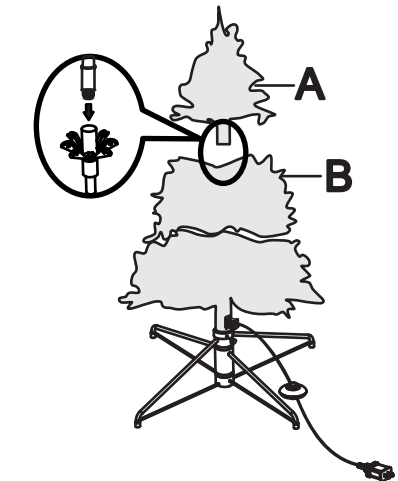
- Insert the middle section (B) of the tree into the bottom section (C).

4 Assembling the tree

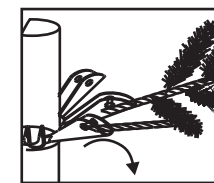
- Insert the top section (A) into the middle section (B).

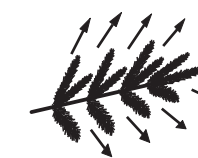
5 Assembling the tree

- Allow branches to fall into place or gently pull branches up and out. When adjusting branches be sure that all wires are free of branch hinges.



6 Assembling the tree

- Shape the branches. Starting with tips closest to the pole, shape one tip to the right, one to the left and one at the center of the main stem. Repeat pattern for each branch.

7 Finishing Assembly

- Plug the well-connected power cord from the tree section (C) into a proper outlet.
- Please note this tree is locked in the Demo function. The tree cycles automatically through 2-5 functions below. The 5 lighting options available are:
 1. Demo
 2. Twinkling
 3. Warm White Steady
 4. Warm White Flashing
 5. Warm White Slow Fade

These functions can be changed by pressing the foot pedal switch or using the remote control after unlocking the Demo function. Please see the **Instructions of remote control** below to see how to unlock and lock the Demo function.

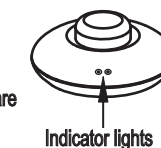
In the condition of Demo function locked, the foot pedal switch only has switch function and timer function. The remote control can be used only by the ON/OFF key and the timing key.

Press the foot pedal switch until one indicator light is on, the tree lights will automatically run through a 6-hours ON, 18-hours OFF cycle.

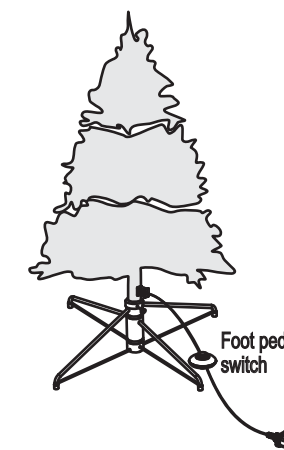
Continually press the foot pedal switch until two indicator lights are on, the tree lights will automatically run through a 8-hours ON, 16-hours OFF cycle.

To turn off the timer function, press the foot pedal switch or OFF button on remote control to turn off the timer.

There is memory mode on timer control even unplug and re-plug the adaptor back on.



Please unlock the Demo function first by using the remote control, then the foot pedal switch and the remote control can work normally. Please see the **Instructions of remote control** below to see how to unlock and lock the Demo function.



Operation

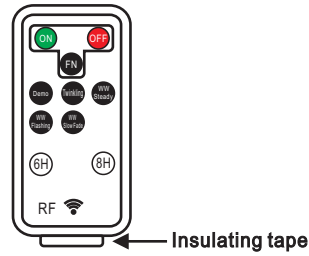
Turning on the tree

- Plug the well-connected power cord from the tree section (C) into a proper outlet.
- Unlock the Demo function. Please see the **Instructions of remote control** below to see how to unlock and lock the Demo function. Press the remote control or foot pedal switch to choose functions and timer control.

Instructions of Remote Control

Please note this tree has a remote control.

Please pull out the insulation tape from the remote control, before starting to use it.



How to Unlock the Demo function:

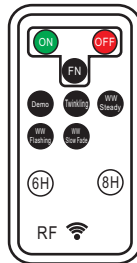
- Press & hold the Demo button on the remote control until the lights flash once, then the foot pedal switch and remote control are unlocked in the Demo function.

How to Lock the Demo function:

- Press & hold the Demo button on the remote control until the lights flash 3 times, then the foot pedal switch and remote control are locked in the Demo function.

Demo function unlocked:

- Press Fn button, select the function below in proper order. Press the function key, select from the following corresponding lighting functions:
 1. Demo
 2. Twinkling
 3. Warm White Steady
 4. Warm White Flashing
 5. Warm White Slow Fade



There is memory mode on function adjustment.

Timer function:

- Press 6H button, one indicator light on the foot pedal switch is on. The tree lights will automatically run through a 6-hours ON, 18-hours OFF cycle.
- Press 8H button, two indicator lights on the foot pedal switch are on. The tree lights will automatically run through a 8-hours ON, 16-hours OFF cycle.

To turn off the timer function, press the foot pedal switch or OFF button on remote control to turn off the timer.

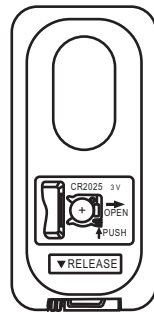
If the remote control does not work, check whether the battery of the remote control is out of power.

To replace the remote control battery:

1. Open the battery case according to the mark on the back of the remote control.
2. Replace with a new button cell "CR2025" (3 volt) into the compartment.

WARNING - This is not a toy and is not intended for use by children.

Care and Cleaning

- Remove all ornaments and decorations.
- Unplug the cord from the wall outlet.
- Gently lift the tree top straight up to remove from the center section and fold all branches towards the pole.
- Repeat this step for the center and bottom tree sections.
- Carefully place all tree sections into a shipping box and tape it shut.
- Store your tree in a cool, dry place away from sunlight.



The tree does not light	Ensure that all tree sections are connected into each other well by pressing each section down and rotating. Make sure power cord plug is securely inserted into a working electrical outlet. If you are still experiencing problems with the tree please call 1-800-986-3460 for instructions.
Top section does not light	Push downward and rotate the top section to B section to make sure they are connected securely. 
Top Section Gap	Pull down each layer branches on top section.
