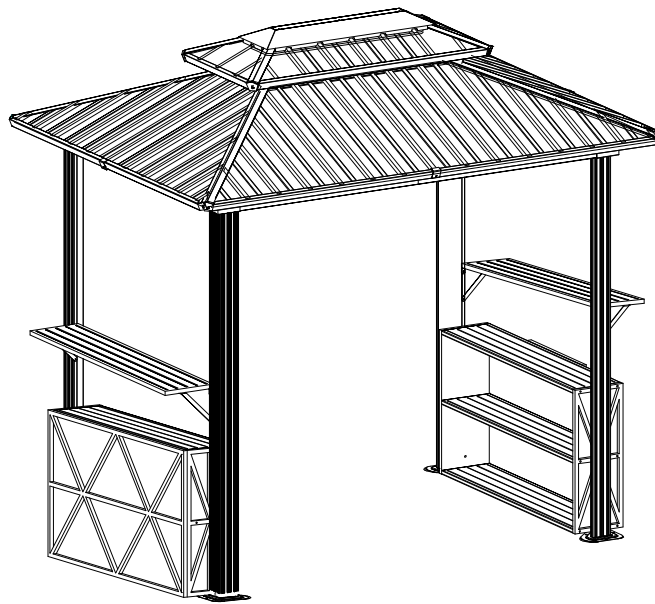

Pre-Assembly

PLANNING ASSEMBLY

Please read this entire instruction manual prior to assembly.

Verify all parts packed in the carton against the parts list. Remove all protective materials and place the parts on a non-abrasive surface to avoid scratching.



NOTE: More than one person may be required to complete the assembly of this product.

To prevent damage, place all parts on a soft surface during assembly.

Tools required for assembly (not included): Allen wrench (included), hammer, screwdriver, stepladder, level and other safety items such as gloves, safety goggles and hardhat.

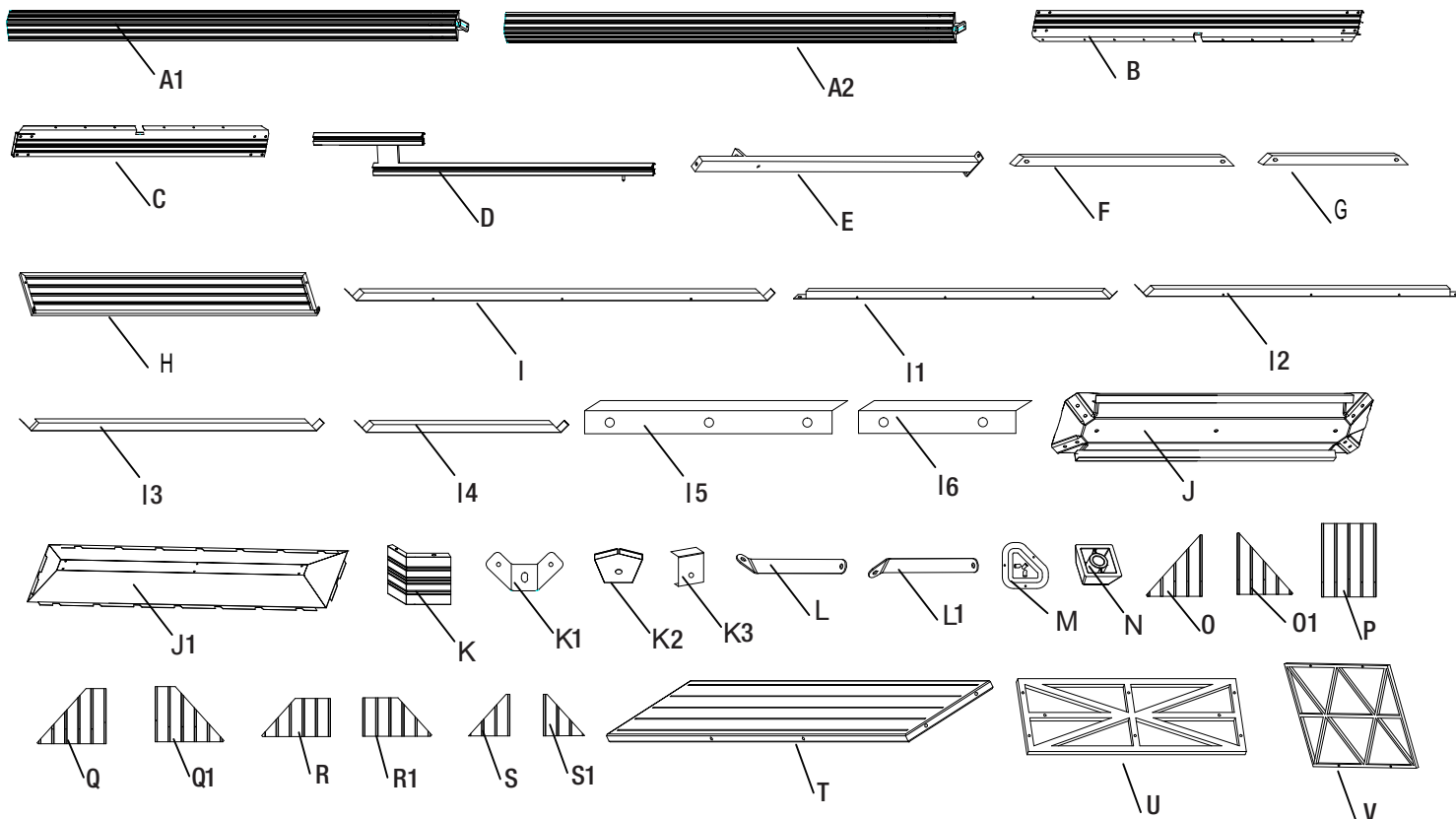

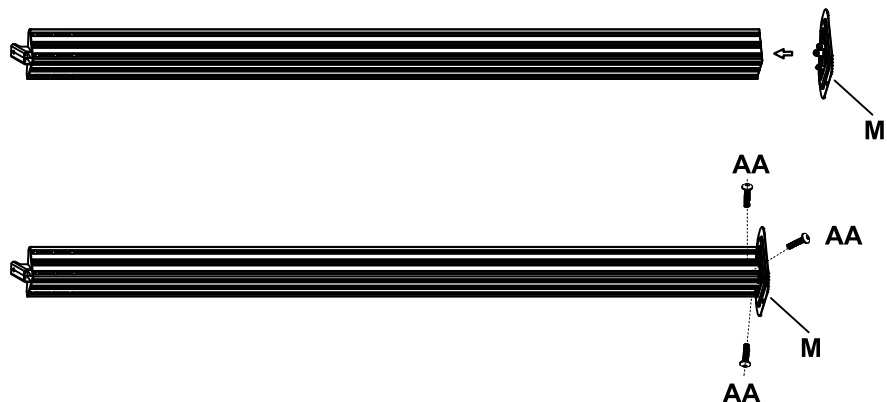
Assembly

1 Attaching the foot base to the pillars

- Attach the foot bases (M) to the pillars 1/2 (A1 and A2) using the M6 x 15 mm bolts (AA) with M6 Allen wrench (JJ).
- Fully tighten all the bolts.
- Please ensure all the four pillars are assembled correctly.

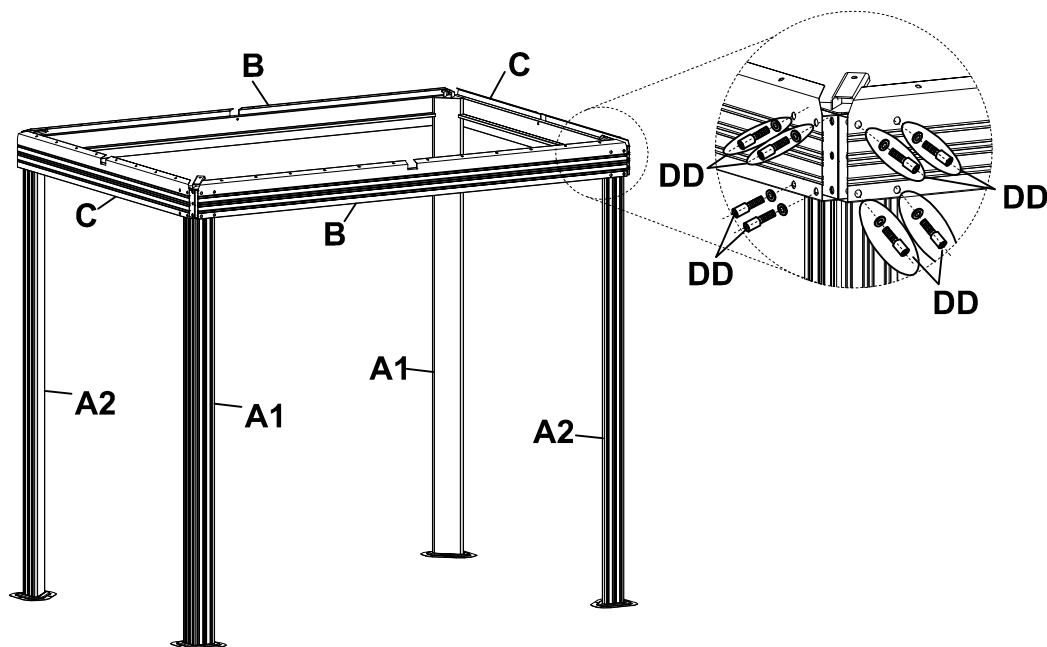


NOTE: Please ensure all bolts are aligned and assembled correctly. Do not tighten bolts until the frame assembly is complete.



2 Attaching the crossbeams to the pillars

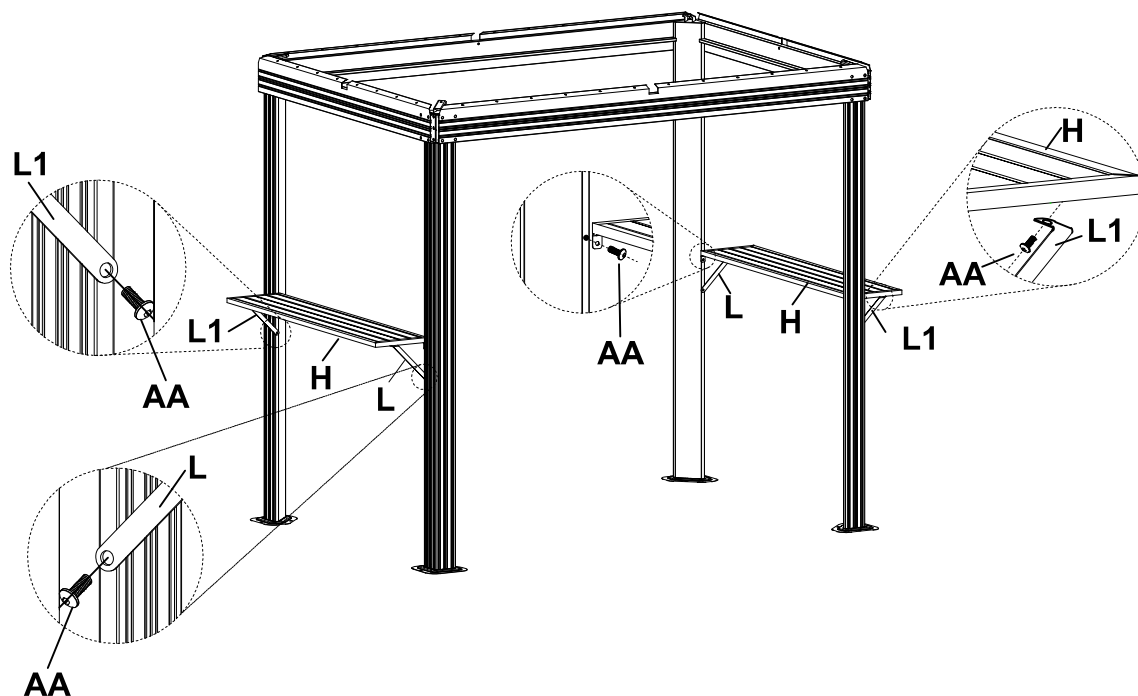
- Attach the long crossbeams (B) and short crossbeams (C) to the pillars 1/2 (A1 and A2) using the M6 x 12 mm bolts and washers (DD).
- Please insure all the four corners need be assembled correctly.



Assembly (continued)

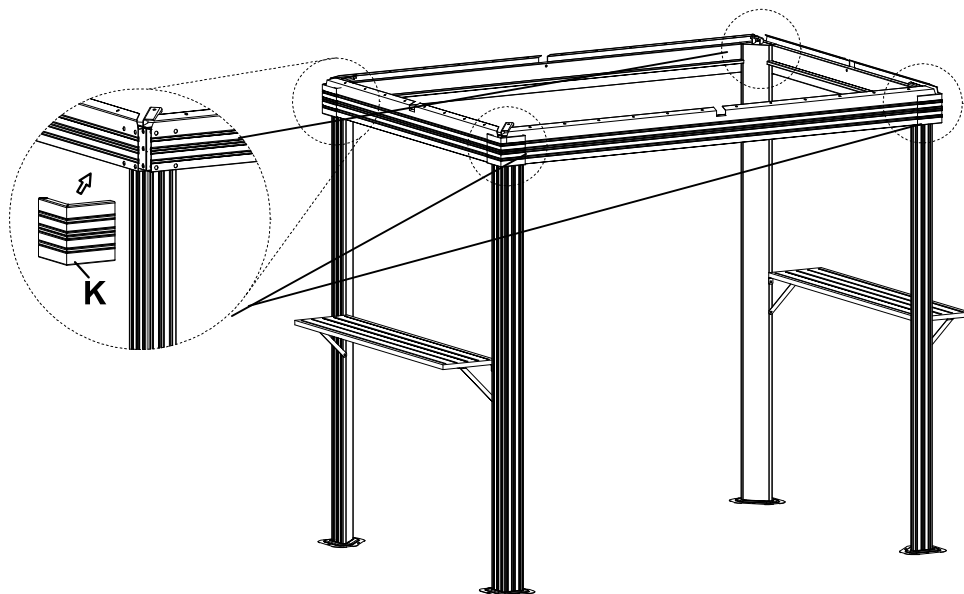
3 Attaching the support brackets to the shelf and pillar

- Attach the support brackets (L and L1) to the shelves 1(H) and pillars 1/2 (A1 and A2) using the M6 x 15 mm bolts (AA).



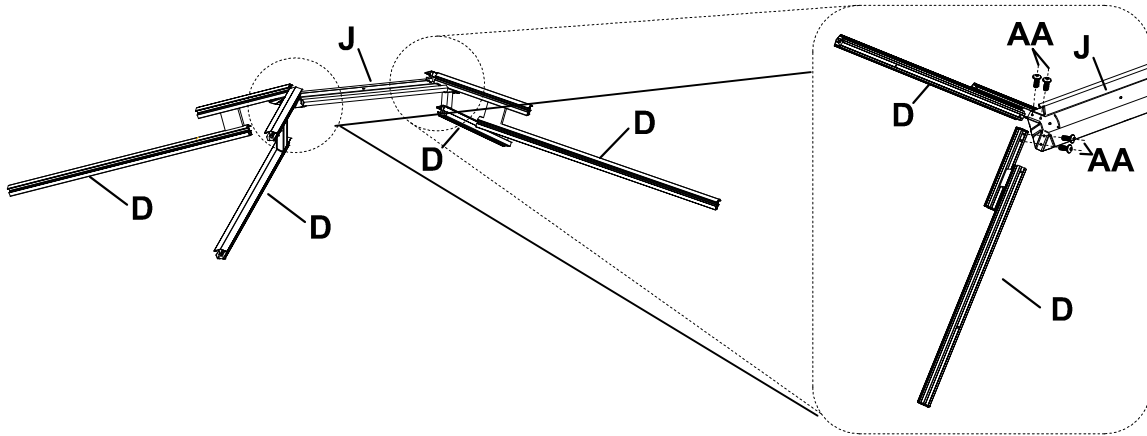
4 Attaching the corner protectors

- Attach the corner protectors (K) to the frame.



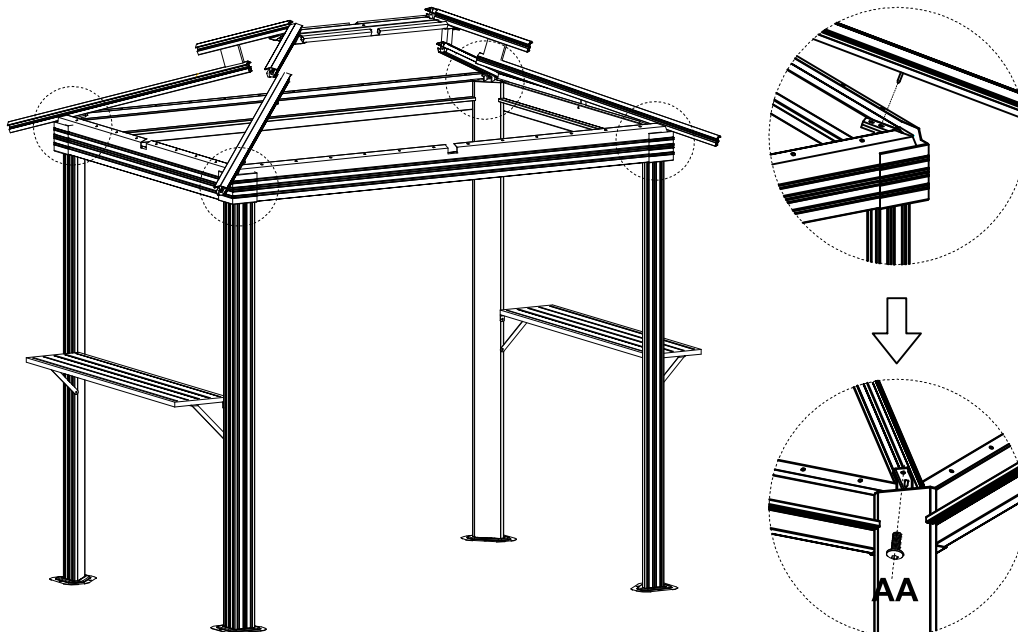
5 Attaching the roof ribs

- Assemble the roof frame by attaching the four roof ribs 1 (D) to the roof top brace (J) using the M6 x 12 mm bolts as shown in the diagram.



6 Attaching the roof to the gazebo frame

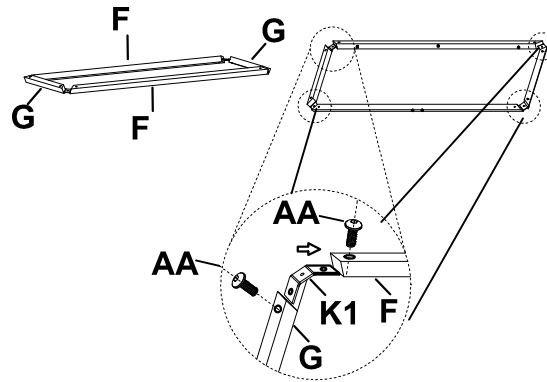
- Attach the roof to the gazebo frame using the M6 x 12 mm bolts (AA).



Assembly (continued)

7 Attaching the roof top support using connectors

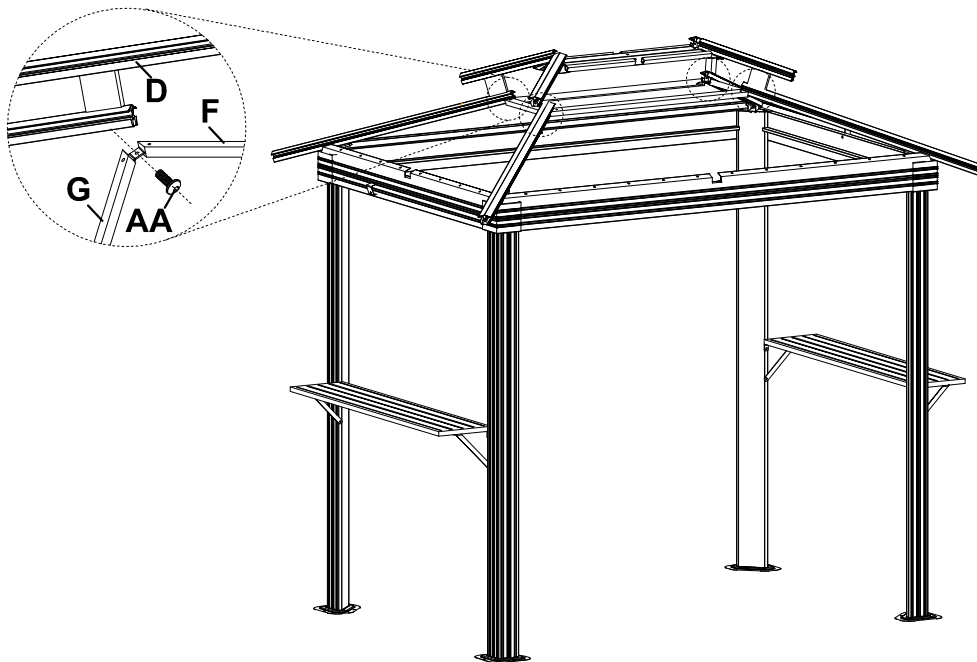
- Attach the two roof top support 2 (G) and two roof top support 1 (F) with connectors 1 (K1) using M6 x 15 mm bolts (AA).



8 Attaching the assembled roof support to the roof ribs

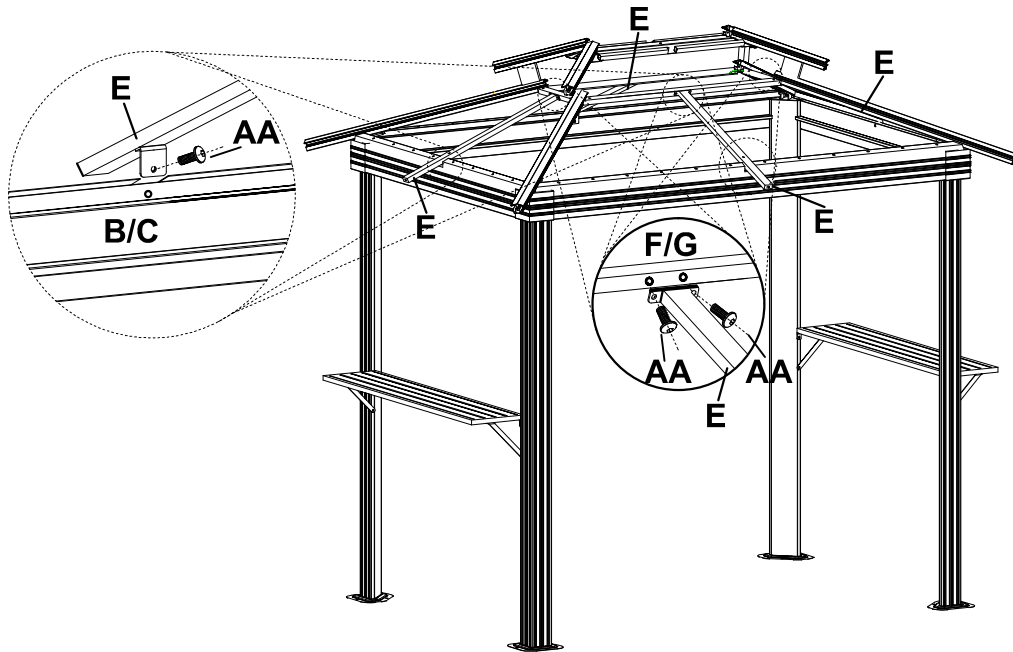
- Attach the assembled roof top support to the roof ribs (D) using the M6 x 15 mm bolts (AA).

Lift the partially assembled roof onto the assembled frame and attach as shown in the diagram.



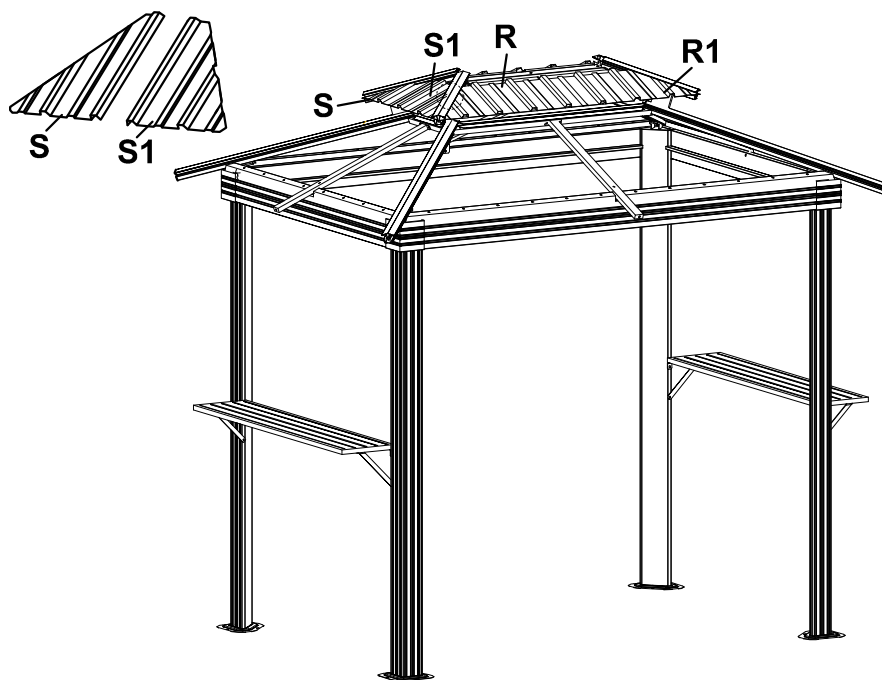
9 Attaching the roof ribs to the assembled roof top support

- Attach the four roof ribs 2 (E) to the assembled roof top (G / F) using the M6 x 15 mm bolts (AA).



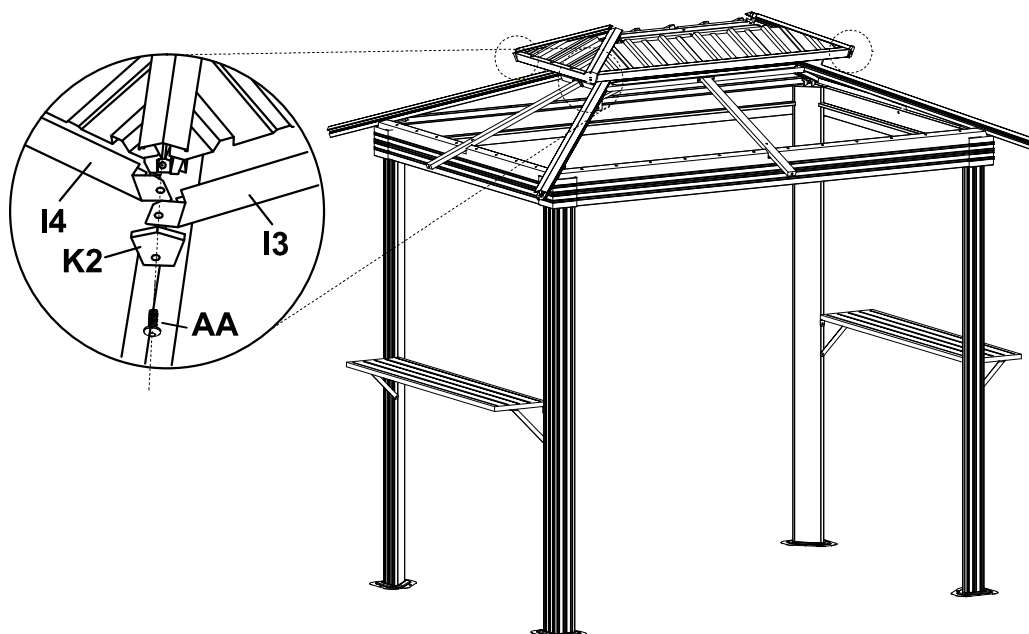
10 Attaching the roof plates

- Install the roof plates 6/7 (R and R1) on the long sides of the Gazebo. Work your way from left to right. Start by sliding the roof plate 6 (R) into position. Then overlap the roof plate 7 (R1) as shown in the diagram and slide the roof plate 7 (R1) into position.
- Install the roof plates 8/9 (S and S1) on the short sides of Gazebo. Work your way from left to right. Start by sliding the roof plate 8 (S) into position. Then overlap the roof plate 9 (S1) as shown in the diagram and slide the roof plate 9 (S1) into position.



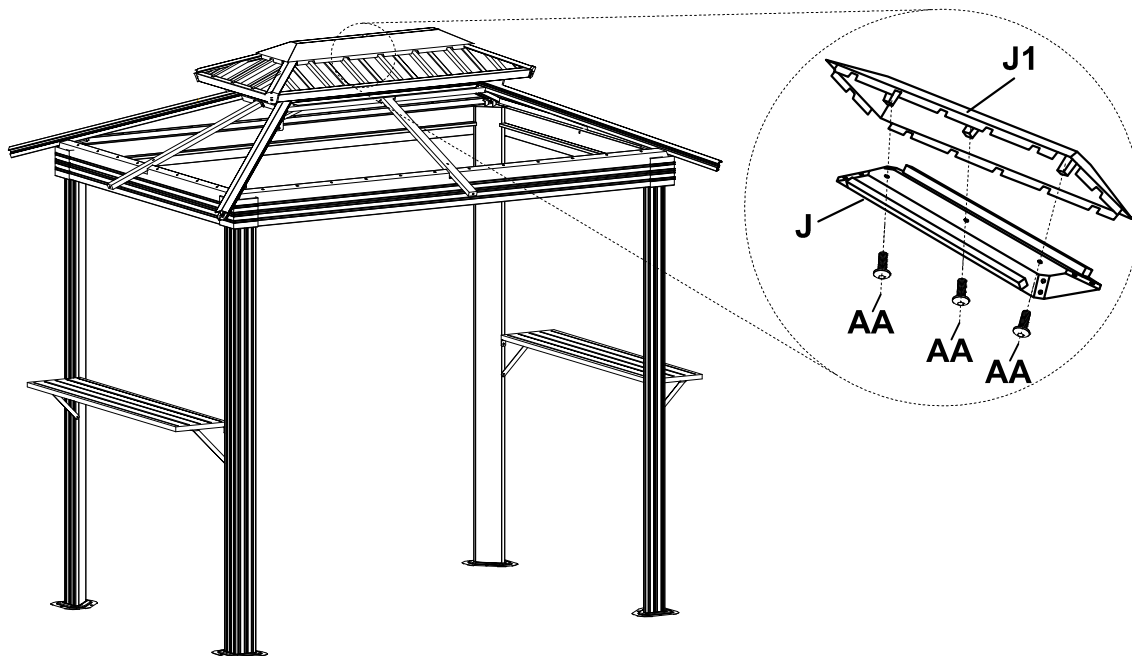
11 Attaching the roof top borders to the roof

- Attach the roof top borders 1 (I3) to the long edge of the roof, and roof top borders 2 (I4) to the short edge of the roof.
- Attach the four corner rib braces (K2) using the M6 x15 mm bolts as shown in the diagram.



12 Attaching the roof top cover to the roof top brace

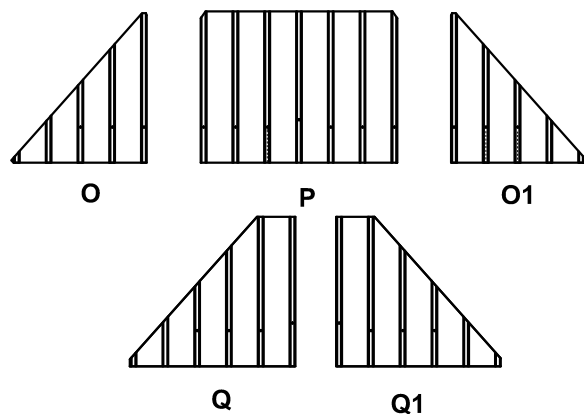
- Attach the roof top cover (J) to the roof top brace (J1) using the M6 x 15 mm bolts (AA).



Assembly (continued)

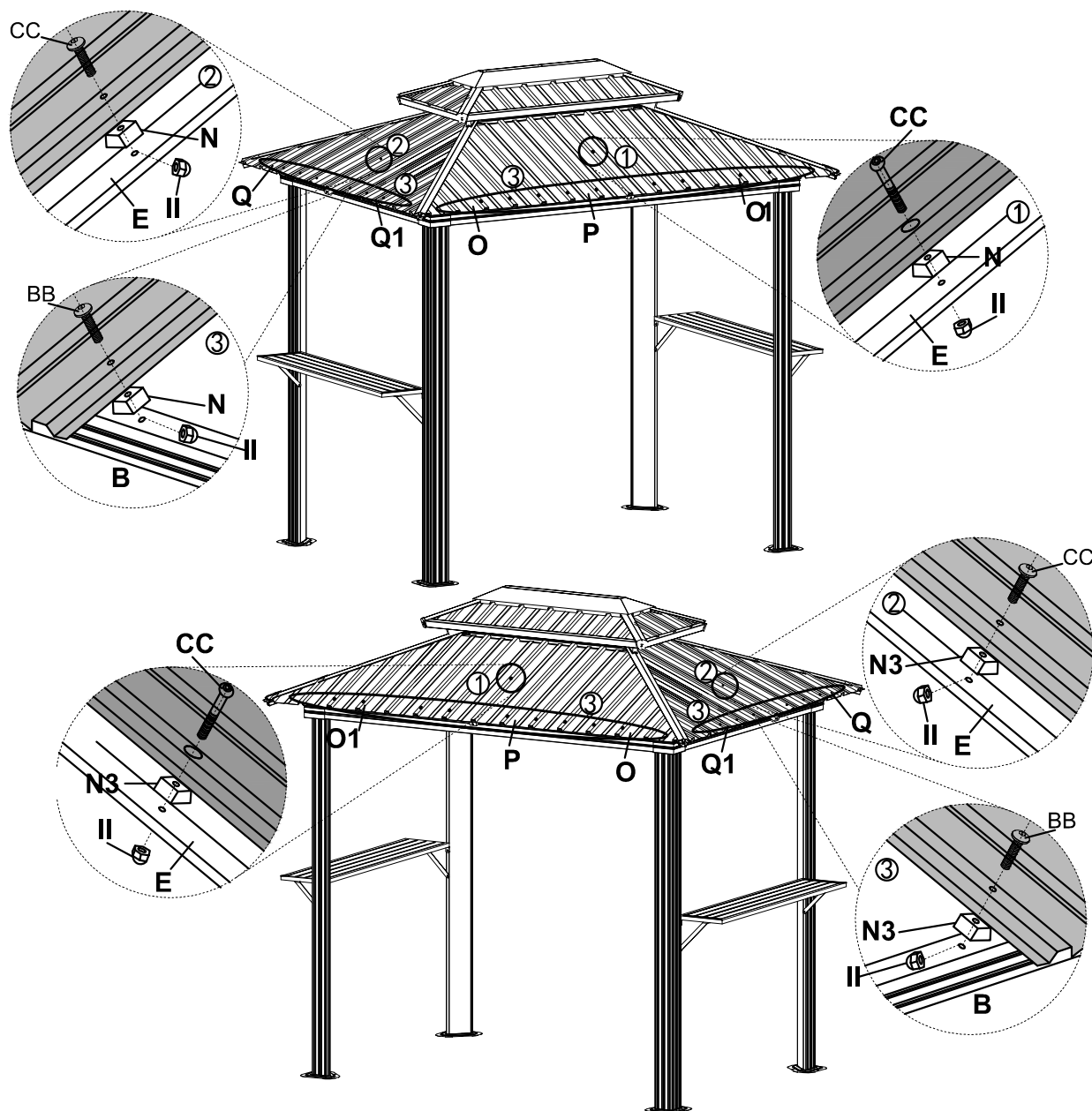
13 Attaching the roof plates O , P, O1, Q, Q1

□ Attach the roof plates 1/2/3/4/5 (O, P, O1, Q, Q1) as shown in the diagram.



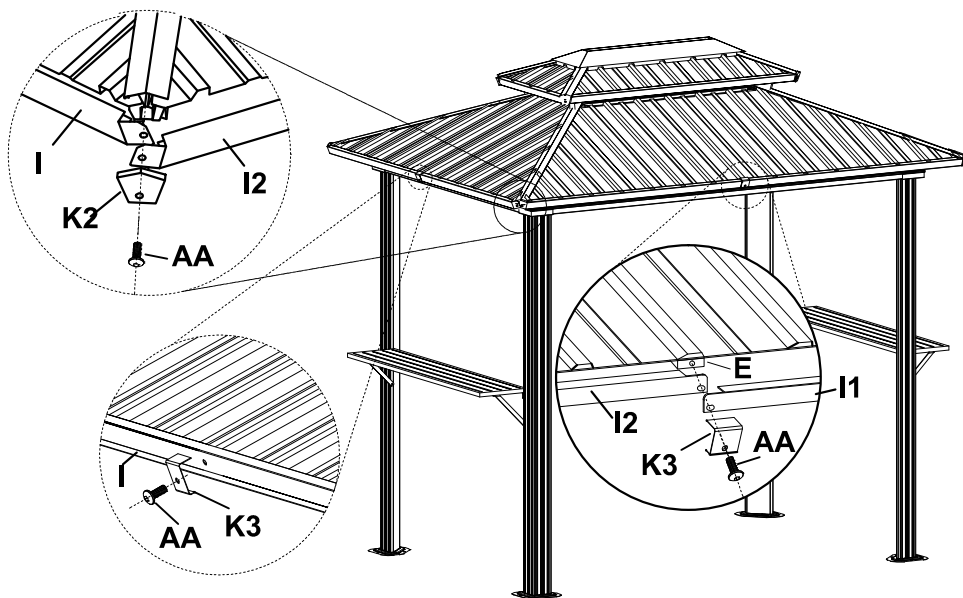
14 Installing the roof plates O, P, O1, Q, Q1 to the gazebo

- Install the roof plates on the long sides of the gazebo. Work your way from left to right. Start by sliding the roof plate (O) into position. Then overlap roof plate (P) as shown in the diagram and slide roof plate (P) into position. Overlap the roof plate (O1) as shown in the diagram and slide roof plate (O1) into position. Affix the roof plates in places by using M6 x 42 mm bolts (CC), M6 nuts (I I) and plastic washers (N) at the positions 1 and 3 on the diagram.
- Install the roof plates on the short sides of the gazebo. Work your way from left to right. Start by sliding the roof plate (Q) into position. Then overlap the roof plate (Q1) as shown in the diagram and slide the roof plate (Q1) into position. Affix the roof plates in their proper places by using the M6 x 25 and M6 x 42 mm bolts (BB and CC), M6 nuts (I I) and plastic washers (N) at the positions 2 and 3 on the diagram.



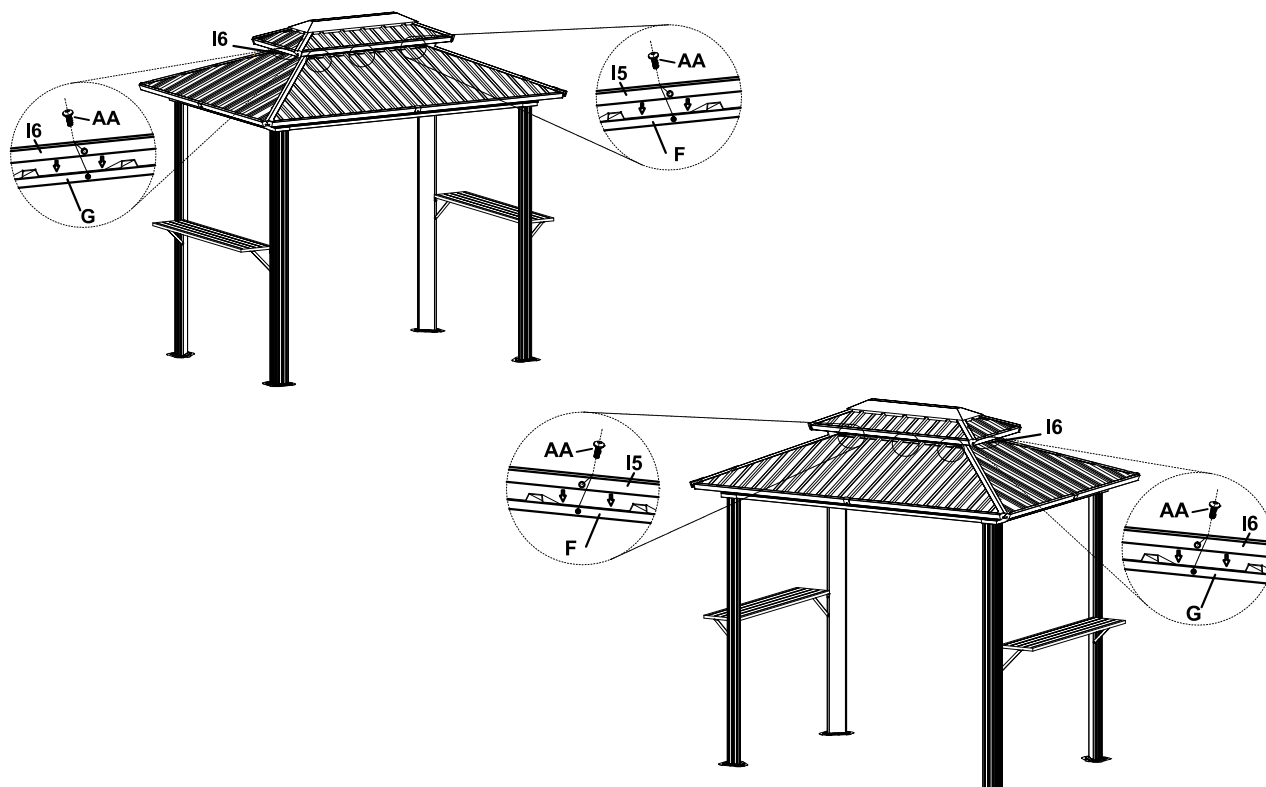
15 Attaching the roof borders to the long edge of the roof

- Attach the roof borders 2 and 3 (I2 / I3) to the long edge of the roof.
- Attach the roof borders 1 (I1) to the short edge of the roof.
- Attach the corner rib braces (K3) as shown in the diagram.
- Attach the corner rib braces (K2) as shown in the diagram.



16 Attaching the roof plate borders to the roof

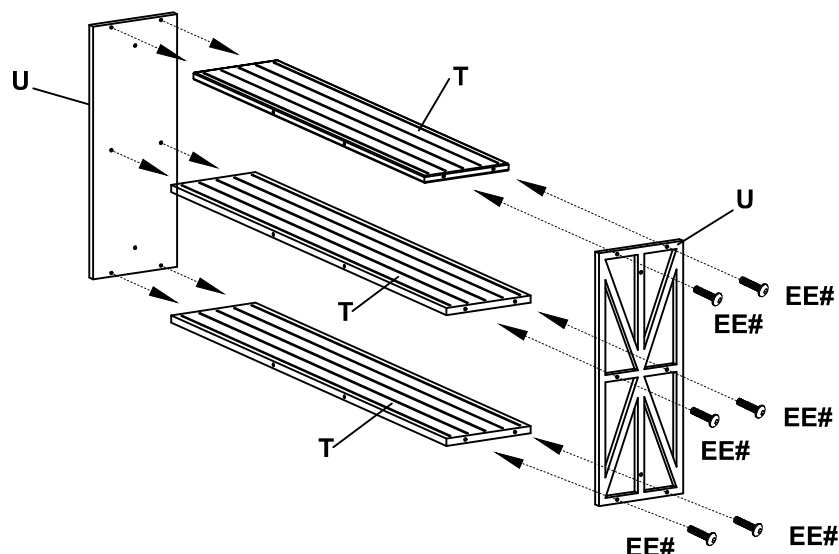
- Attach the roof plate border 1 (I5) to the long edge of the roof, and the roof plate border 2 (I6) to the short edge of the roof as shown in the diagram using the M6 x 15 mm bolts (AA).



Assembly (continued)

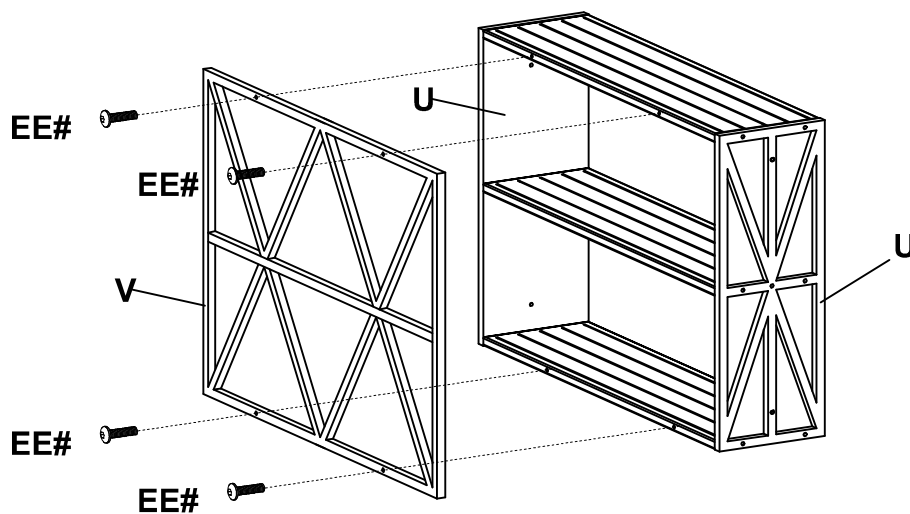
17 Attach the side panel to the shelf

- Attach the side panel of shelves (U) to the shelves 2 (T) using the M6 x 35 mm bolts (EE) .
- Attach another shelf in the same way.



18 Attaching the back panel to the shelf

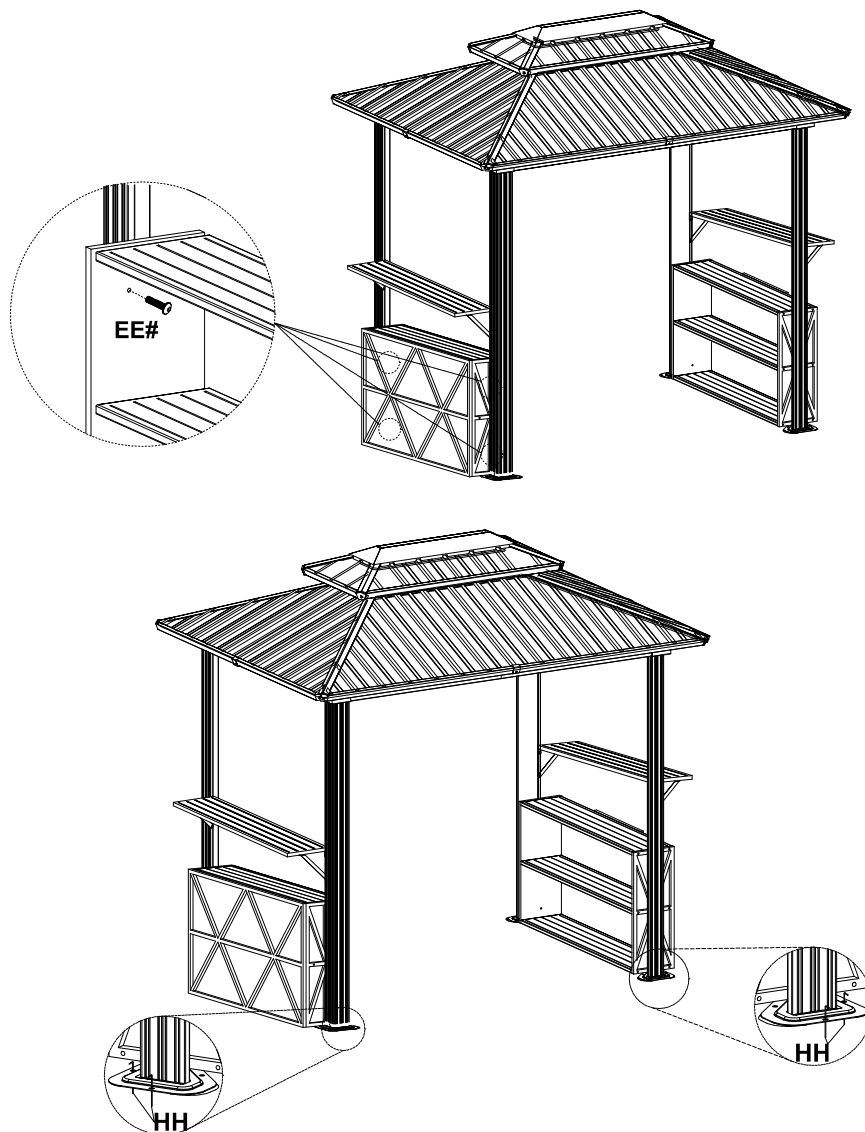
- Attach the back panel of shelves (V) to the shelf frame using the M6 x 35 mm bolts (EE) .
- Attach another shelf in the same way.



Assembly (continued)

19 Attaching the shelf box to the pillars

- Attach the shelf box to the pillars 1/2 (A1 and A2) using the M6 x 35 mm bolts.
- Adjust the position of the gazebo and insert the stakes (HH) into the holes of all the four foot bases.



Care and Maintenance

- For cleaning, use a mild detergent solution, rinse with water, and allow to air dry. Do not use acetone, abrasive, or other special detergents as they would be harmful to the product's finish.
- Due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if this protective coating is scratched. This is a natural process. To minimize this condition, it is recommended that care be taken when assembling and handling the product in order to prevent the paint from being scratched.
