HOW IT WORKS

This is a manually operated jack for emergency purposes only. To use, insert the hook end of the 2-part handle system into the eyehole at the end of the jack and begin turning clockwise to raise the jack. Turn the handle counterclockwise to lower the jack. Make sure the saddle is properly positioned before raising the vehicle.
