

Garden Hose Storage Box User Guide

Thank you for choosing this garden hose storage box! The product requires no installation and is ready to use right out of the box, helping you keep your garden hose organized and tangle-free while adding a decorative touch to your outdoor space.

I. Package Contents Check

After unboxing, please confirm all components are included and intact. The product comes fully assembled, no additional installation required:

- 1 x Hose storage box body (steel material with powder coating and hammered copper finish)
- 1 x Matching storage box lid (fits seamlessly with the box body)

II. Core Product Features

- Generous Capacity: Can hold up to 100 feet of garden hose, keeping your outdoor space neat and clutter-free.
- Durable Material: Constructed with iron and steel, lightweight (5.8 lbs) yet sturdy, featuring a powder coating and hammered copper finish for an elegant look.
- Practical Design: Equipped with drainage holes at the bottom, and the base is slightly elevated to prevent water immersion.
- Decorative & Versatile: Adds a stylish accent to backyards, patios, balconies, or porches, combining functionality with aesthetic appeal.
- Compact Size: Measures 14 inches (L) x 14 inches (W) x 15 inches (H) including the lid, saving outdoor space.

III. Correct Usage Instructions

1. Hose Storage Operation

- Open the lid of the storage box and place the garden hose into the box in a circular or layered manner. Avoid forcing or twisting the hose to prevent tangling.
- After storing the hose, cover the lid tightly to protect the hose from dust, debris, and direct sunlight, extending its service life.
- Ensure the drainage holes at the bottom are not blocked by soil or other objects to maintain smooth water drainage.

2. Placement Recommendations

- Choose a flat, dry area in your backyard, patio, balcony, or porch for placement. The elevated base helps avoid contact with standing water.
- Keep the storage box away from sharp objects or heavy items to prevent scratches or damage to the powder coating and copper finish.
- For optimal stability, avoid placing the box on sloped surfaces or areas prone to strong winds.

IV. Maintenance & Care

- Before outdoor use, it is recommended to apply an additional layer of rust-resistant enamel paint to enhance corrosion resistance, especially in humid or coastal environments.
- Regularly wipe the box body and lid with a soft dry cloth to remove dust, dirt, or water stains, maintaining the luster of the hammered copper finish.
- Check the drainage holes periodically and clear any blockages to ensure water can drain effectively, preventing internal moisture buildup.

- If the surface becomes scratched, touch up with matching paint in a timely manner to prevent rusting of the steel material.
- During long-term storage or harsh weather conditions, move the box to a covered area or use a protective cover to extend its lifespan.

V. Safety Tips

- Ensure the storage box is placed on a stable, flat surface to prevent tipping when storing or retrieving the hose.
- Keep the box away from young children to avoid accidental pinching or trapping during lid opening/closing.
- Do not overload the box with hoses longer than 100 feet or other heavy items, as this may damage the structure.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners or hard brushes when cleaning, as they may scratch the powder coating and copper finish.
