

LIGHTS FAST - Just light the wrapper

ALWAYS START WITH TWO LOGS.

NOT INTENDED AS A SINGLE LOG FIRE.

## INSTRUCTIONS

FOR USE IN OUTDOOR WOOD BURNING FIRE PITS, FIREPLACES & CAMPFIRES.

- Can also be used in indoor, open hearth fireplaces.
- Without tearing, carefully pull on seams of the wrappers to separate it from the log and create an
  airspace.
- Stack two (2) logs in an X configuration on the grate of a fire pit, fireplace or on the base of a campfire pit or fire ring. Place the logs so the arrows are pointing down.
- Light seams of the wrappers at the arrows.
   For best conditions for roasting, wait until the fire begins to die.
- For best conditions for roasting, wait until the fire begins to die down some (after about 45-60 min.) when some hot coals are present.
- Always use a metal fireplace screen while burning indoors. If fireplace has glass doors leave doors open while burning.
- Add an additional log (ONLY ONE), if desired, after about 1.5 hours and flames from the first logs have begun to diminish. Additional logs may be added to extend the fire, but never add more than ONE log per hour.
- Careful adjustment of the logs with a fireplace tool is acceptable but make sure no burning particles stick to the tool.
