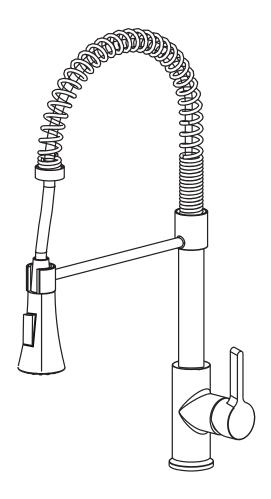

Simply, return the product / part to any of the Home Depot retail locations or call 1-855-HD-GLACIER (1-855-434-5224) to receive the replacement item. Proof of purchase (original sales receipt) from the original consumer purchaser must be made available for all Glacier Bay warranty claims.

This warranty excludes incidental/inconsequential damages and failures due to misuse, abuse or normal wear and tear. This warranty excludes all industrial, commercial & business usage, whose purchasers are hereby, extended a five year limited warranty from the date of purchase, with all other terms of this warranty applying except the duration of warranty.

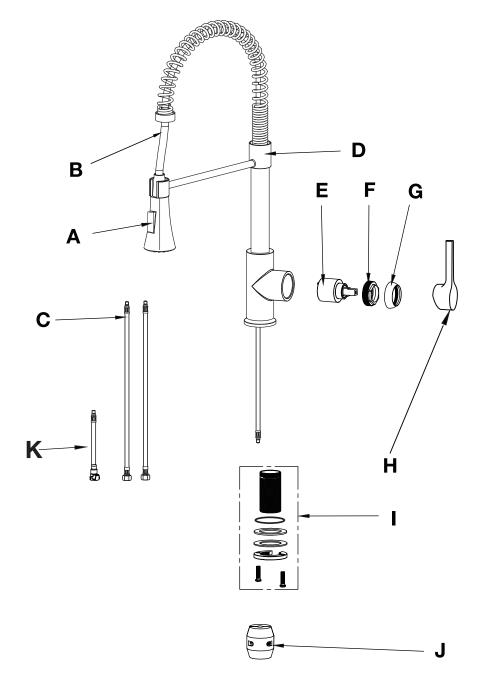

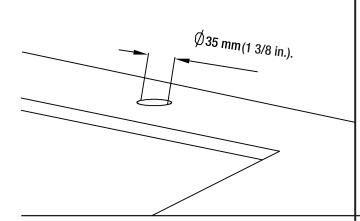
Installation (continued)

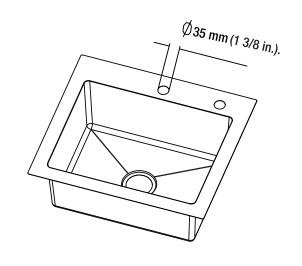
1 Preparing for installation



CAUTION: Always shut off the water supply before removing or replacing any part of a faucet. Open the handle to relieve water pressure and ensure that the water is completely shut off.

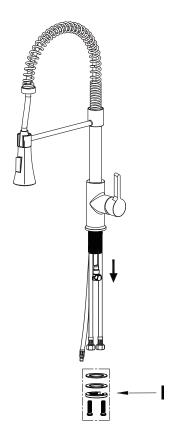
- □ Pre-drilled hole size: 35 mm (1 3/8 in.).
- □ Install on countertop or kitchen sink.





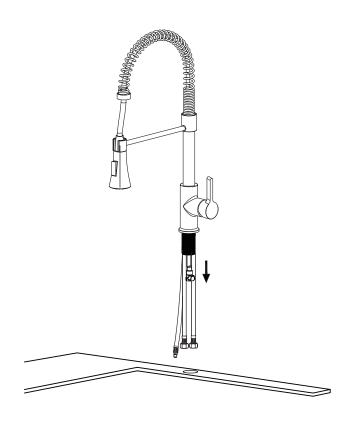
2 Removing mounting hardware

Remove the mounting shank (I) (mounting nut, rubber and metal washer) from the mounting pipe.



3 Assembling the faucet

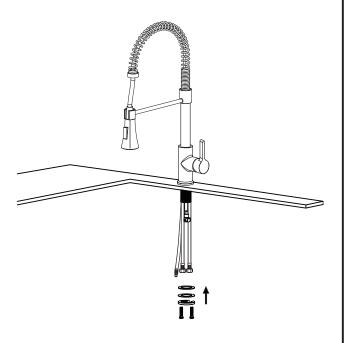
 Insert the faucet body into the hole in the countertop or sink.



Installation (continued)

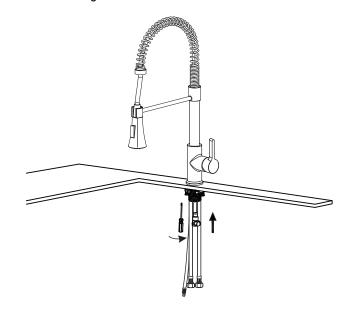
4 Installing mounting hardware

 Install mounting hardware from underneath the countertop to the faucet.



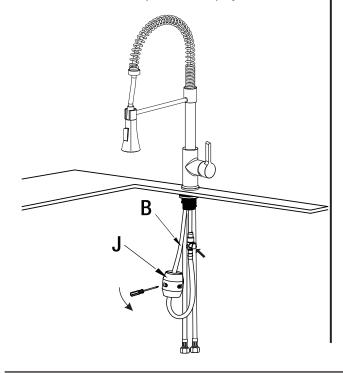
5 Securing mounting hardware

 Tighten mounting nut and mounting screws with a Phillips screwdriver until snug. Do not overtighten.



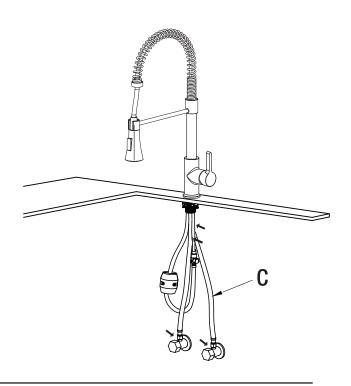
6 Attaching the quick connector to outlet hose and install the weight

- Push the quick connector of spray hose (B) firmly upward and attach it to the receiving block of outlet hose. Push until a "Click" is heard.
- Connect the spray hose and install the weight (J) on the lowest vertical point on the spray hose.

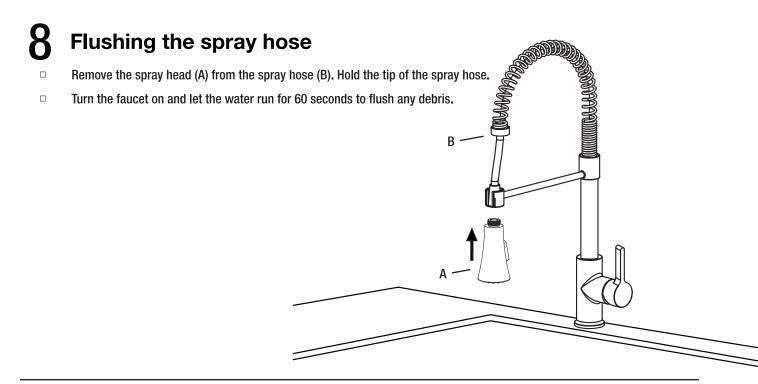


Connecting the supply lines

- Connect supply lines (C) to hot and cold copper lines.
 Connect supply lines (C) to angle stops.
- Tighten both ends of supply lines (C) with a wrench until snug. Turn on hot and cold angle stops and check for leaks.



Installation (continued)



Care and Maintenance

- □ To clean, wipe down with a damp cloth and dry with a towel
- □ Do not use abrasive cleaners, steel wool, or harsh chemicals when cleaning this faucet, or the warranty will be voided.

Troubleshooting



NOTE: Refer to the services parts on the website for a detailed drawing showing the location of the parts listed below.

Problem	Possible Cause	Measure
There are leaks underneath the handle.	The screw nut has come loose and the o-ring on the cartridge is dirty or damaged.	☐ Tighten the screw nut. Clean or replace the cartridge or o-ring.
The aerator leaks or has an inconsistent water flow pattern.	The aerator is dirty or misfitted. The cartridge may be clogged.	Remove the aerator and check for debris in the aerator screens.
pattorni		Remove the cartridge and check for debris.
		□ Ensure the aerator is properly installed.
There are leaks from the hose underneath the deck.	The supply lines and outlet hose connection may be loose.	☐ Tighten the connection of the hoses.
The hose does not retract.	The weight is not installed in the appropriate position.	□ Reinstall or readjust the weight.
The water pressure is low.	The connector underneath the deck is clogged with debris. The aerator is clogged.	☐ Turn off the supply lines and disconnect the connector / aerator.
		 Unscrew the connector / aerator and clean under running water.
		□ Screw the connector / aerator back.
		☐ Test water flow. If water pressure is still low then replace the connector / aerator.
There is no hot or cold water.	The supply lines was accidentally kinked during installation and is limiting the water flow through.	□ Reinstall the supply lines.
