

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# Warranty

### 3 Year Frame / 2 Year Fabric Limited Warranty

### What is Covered

We warrant the frame to be free of manufacturing defects to the original purchaser for three years and the fabric for two years.

### What is Not Covered

It remains the customer's responsibility for freight and packaging charges to and from our service center. This warranty does not cover commercial use, hardware, acts of nature, fire, freezing and abusive use. In addition, purchased parts are not covered under this warranty. We reserve the right to make substitutions with similar merchandise, if the model in question is no longer in production.

## **Pre-Assembly**


### PLANNING ASSEMBLY

Identify all parts packed in the carton against the parts list. Remove all protective materials. Place parts on a non-abrasive surface to avoid scratching. If you are missing any parts or are unsure how to proceed with the assembly, call our Customer Service Team at 1-855-HD-HAMPTON. Do not attempt assembly if any parts are missing or damaged.

Two people may be required to assemble the chaise.




## **Assembly**



**Important note:** The basic assembly of the chaise lounge is to attach the back frame to the lounge frame. We recommend two people work together to line up the holes on the back frame with the fixed nut holes on the lounge frame to ensure the bolts are on a straight, direct path. Starting the bolts at an angle could cause cross threading which will ruin the entire lounge frame.


# Assembling the sling seat frame

- Attach the left arm (C) to the sling seat frame (A) by using the four bolts (DD) and washers (EE).
- Guide the bolt (DD) through the hole in the sling seat frame
  (A) and into the pre-drilled hole in the left arm (C).
- Hand tighten three to four turns only. (Do not tighten completely.)
- □ Repeat for the right arm (D).



# 2 Assembling the chaise back

- From behind the chaise lounge back frame (B), add a washer (EE) to the bolt (CC) and insert the bolt (CC) through the hole in the lower sling back frame (B).
- Add a plastic washer (FF) before inserting it into the fixed nut inside the sling seat frame (A).
- □ Hand tighten 2-3 turns only. (Do not tighten completely.)
- Repeat on the opposite side.





**Important note:** Each bolt must be tightened a few turns at a time. Start with a bolt on one side and then move to the bolt on the opposite side. Continue this method of turning each bolt a few times until lounge frame and sling evenly. Do not over tighten. Over tightening may damage the threads on the bolts and the entire chaise lounge.

# 3 Tightening the bolts

Using the hex bolt driver (AA) provided,
 tighten all bolts and add bolt covers (BB).

### **Maintenance**

### FRAME:

Periodically clean and dry thoroughly. Be sure to drain any water accumulated inside the frames. To thoroughly drain the frames, remove the foot caps and tilt the frames, if necessary, to remove all water. This is critical. Water allowed to accumulate inside the frames and then exposed to sub-freezing temperatures can cause damage to the frame tubing. Such damage is not covered under the warranty. Always clean, drain, and dry thoroughly before storing for the winter. For best results, always store or cover your furniture when not in use. We recommend commercially available outdoor furniture covers. Any small nicks or scratches can be covered with a light application of touchup paint.

### FABRIC (CUSHIONS/SLINGS):

The best way to maintain the beauty of cushions and slings is to store them in a dry area and out of the elements when not in use or cover with commercially available outdoor furniture covers.

## **Care and Cleaning**

### FRAME:

Use mild soap and warm water. Do not use abrasive materials, cleansers, or bleach products. Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly.

### FABRIC (CUSHIONS/SLINGS):

Wipe minor spills immediately. Clean with mild soap, warm clean water, and a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive materials, cleansers, or bleach products. Although fabric has been treated to resist stains, occasional use of commercially available fabric cleaners may be necessary. Follow the manufacturer's instructions.
