

Installation Instructions for 10 x 20 Ft Carport Replacement Canopy Cover

Tools Needed

- None (no complex tools required)

Before Installation

1. Inspect Components

- Carefully check the canopy cover for any signs of damage during transit, such as tears or holes. Also, count the 36 ball bungee cords to ensure all are present.

2. Prepare the Frame

- Ensure the carport frame is clean, stable, and free of any sharp objects that could damage the canopy cover. Make sure the frame is properly assembled and in good condition.

Installation Steps

Step 1: Unroll the Canopy Cover

1. Choose a large, clean, and flat area near the carport frame.
2. Carefully unroll the white canopy cover. Take your time to avoid creating any permanent creases or folds.

Step 2: Position the Canopy Cover

1. With the help of an assistant (if possible), lift the unrolled canopy cover and place it over the carport frame.
2. Align the canopy cover so that it evenly covers the frame. Ensure that

the length and width dimensions match up with the frame's sides.

Step 3: Secure with Ball Bungee Cords

1. Start from one corner of the carport. Take a ball bungee cord and attach one end to the loop or attachment point on the canopy cover.
2. Stretch the bungee cord across to the corresponding attachment point on the carport frame and secure the other end.
3. Continue this process around the entire perimeter of the carport, working your way along the sides and corners. Make sure to keep the canopy cover taut as you attach the bungee cords.
4. As you attach the bungee cords, periodically check that the canopy cover is evenly distributed and there are no areas that are sagging or overly tight.

Post - Installation Checks

1. Tug Test

- Gently tug on the edges of the canopy cover in a few places to ensure that it is securely attached and the bungee cords are holding it firmly in place.

2. Inspection

- Walk around the carport and visually inspect the canopy cover for any areas that may need further adjustment. Check that all bungee cords are properly fastened and not tangled.

Tips

- If you encounter any difficulty in stretching the bungee cords to reach the attachment points, try adjusting the position of the canopy cover slightly to make the connection easier.
- In case of strong winds or severe weather approaching, it is advisable to double - check the security of the bungee cords to ensure the canopy cover remains in place.
