

Wall Shelves - Simple Installation & Care Manual

Standard Shelves (keyhole mount; screws + drywall anchors)

What's Included

- Wall shelf panel(s) with keyhole slots on the back.
- Mounting hardware: typically 2 screws + 2 drywall anchors per shelf (quantity may vary by set).

Tools You'll Need

- Measuring tape, pencil, level.
- Drill and Phillips screwdriver.
- Stud finder (recommended).

Install Your Shelf (Keyhole Mount - Studs Recommended)

- Find a stud and mark the centerline(s) where the keyholes will sit.
- Hold shelf at desired height and level it.
- Measure the distance between the two keyhole centers on the shelf and transfer those marks to the wall.
- Pre-drill pilot holes into studs at your marks.
- Drive screws into the wall, leaving heads out about 1/8-3/16 in so keyholes can slide over them.
- Align keyholes over screw heads, then lower the shelf to lock in place.
- Check level and adjust screw depth if needed.

Install Your Shelf (Keyhole Mount - Drywall Anchors)

- Level shelf and mark keyhole center points on the wall.
- Drill holes sized for the included anchors.
- Tap anchors flush with the wall.
- Drive screws into anchors, leaving heads out about 1/8-3/16 in.
- Hang shelf by aligning keyholes over screws and sliding down to lock.
- Check level; fine-tune by slightly adjusting screw depth.

Care & Cleaning

- Dust with a soft, dry cloth.
- Wipe with a damp cloth and mild soap if needed; dry right away.
- Avoid harsh or abrasive cleaners.
- Do not exceed the shelf's weight rating shown on the product label/page.
