#### How do I remove the Goof Off<sup>®</sup> Pro Strength residue?

Goof Off<sup>®</sup> Pro Strength Remover evaporates quickly and does not leave a residue. If there appears to be a residue, the surface hasn't been cleaned well enough. Reapply the Goof Off<sup>®</sup> Pro with a rag and rub the surface until clean.
