

Pre-assembly

PLANNING ASSEMBLY

Ensure all parts and components are present before beginning assembly. Assemble on a soft, smooth surface to prevent damage to product finish. Do not overtighten screws and bolts to avoid stripping.



NOTE: DO NOT use power tools.





Assembly


Attaching the stretchers

☐ Attach the stretchers (D) to the side frame (B) with bolts (AA). Tighten with Allen wrench (CC) after all bolts are completely lined up and inserted into the holes.



2 Attaching the side frame


Attach the side frame (B) to the stretchers (C) and (D) with bolts (AA) and tighten with Allen wrench (CC).



3 Attaching the table top

☐ Put the table top (A) on a soft, smooth surface and attach the metal frame to the back of top with screws (BB).

Use a Phillips screwdriver (not included) to tighten the screws.




4 Tightening all the bolts

☐ Put the table on the level surface and fully tighten all bolts previously installed with allen wrench. Tighten all the bolts on a level surface.



NOTE: If the table legs are not on the floor. You can adjust levelers properly (on the bottom of legs) You may need to loosen the bolts. Apply some weight on the table to get all legs on the floor and then tighten the bolts at that positon.



Maintenance

Check bolts/screws periodically and tighten them if necessary.

Care and Cleaning

- Dust this item regularly with a soft, lint-free cloth to prevent soil buildup.
- □ Wipe away spills immediately to prevent staining using a clean cloth dampened with water.
- Do not use liquid or abrasive cleaners on the metal frame, as this may damage the finish.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution
Not all of the product's legs touch the floor.	Make sure adjustable center feet levelers are adjusted properly. The levelers are pre-assembled on the bottom of the legs.
the noof.	The product is KD construction. You may need to loosen the bolts and place the product on a flat surface. Ensure that the legs all touch the flat surface and then re-tighten the bolts.
	Loosen all the bolts and apply some weight to the product to get all the feet to touch the floor. Then re-tighten the bolts in that position.
One or more of the bolts do not fit in the holes correctly.	The product is KD construction. Do not fully tighten the bolts before all the bolts are completely lined up and inserted into holes. Loosen the bolts and make sure all bolts are lined up and inserted into the holes.
