

Use and Care Manual – Metal and Wood Bed Frame

1. Important Safety Information

Read all instructions before assembly and use.

Only use the bed frame on a flat, stable, and level surface.

Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity: 700lbs ~ 1000 lbs.

Ensure all screws and bolts are fully tightened before use.

Keep small parts away from children during assembly.

Do not jump on the bed or apply sudden impact to the frame.

2. Proper Use

Designed for indoor, residential use only.

Suitable for use with a standard mattress (no box spring required unless preferred).

Make sure the mattress fully covers the frame and sits securely on the steel slats.

Regularly check the frame to ensure all components remain stable.

3. Assembly Care

Assemble on a soft surface to avoid scratching the wood and metal parts.

Follow the step-by-step assembly instructions included in the package.

Do not use power tools; hand-tighten to avoid over-tightening or stripping screws.

4. Cleaning Instructions

Wood Headboard:

Wipe with a soft, dry or slightly damp cloth.

Do not use abrasive cleaners, bleach, or solvents.

Metal Frame and Steel Slats:

Clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent if needed.

Dry thoroughly to prevent rust or corrosion.

Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the finish.

5. Care and Maintenance

Check screws and bolts every 3–6 months and tighten if necessary.

Inspect the metal slats regularly to ensure they are not bent or damaged.

Avoid placing the bed in humid or extremely dry environments to protect the wood panels.

Use felt pads on the feet if placing the bed on hardwood floors to prevent scratches.

6. Storage Guidelines

If storing for a long period, disassemble the frame and wrap wooden parts in protective material.

Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and moisture.

Keep all hardware in a labeled bag for future reassembly.

7. Troubleshooting

Squeaking or noise:

Check and tighten all connection points.

Add non-slip pads between the mattress and frame if necessary.

Frame feels unstable:

Recheck assembly steps and ensure all screws are fully secured.

Make sure the bed is placed on a level surface.
